The relationship between river channel pattern and bed material

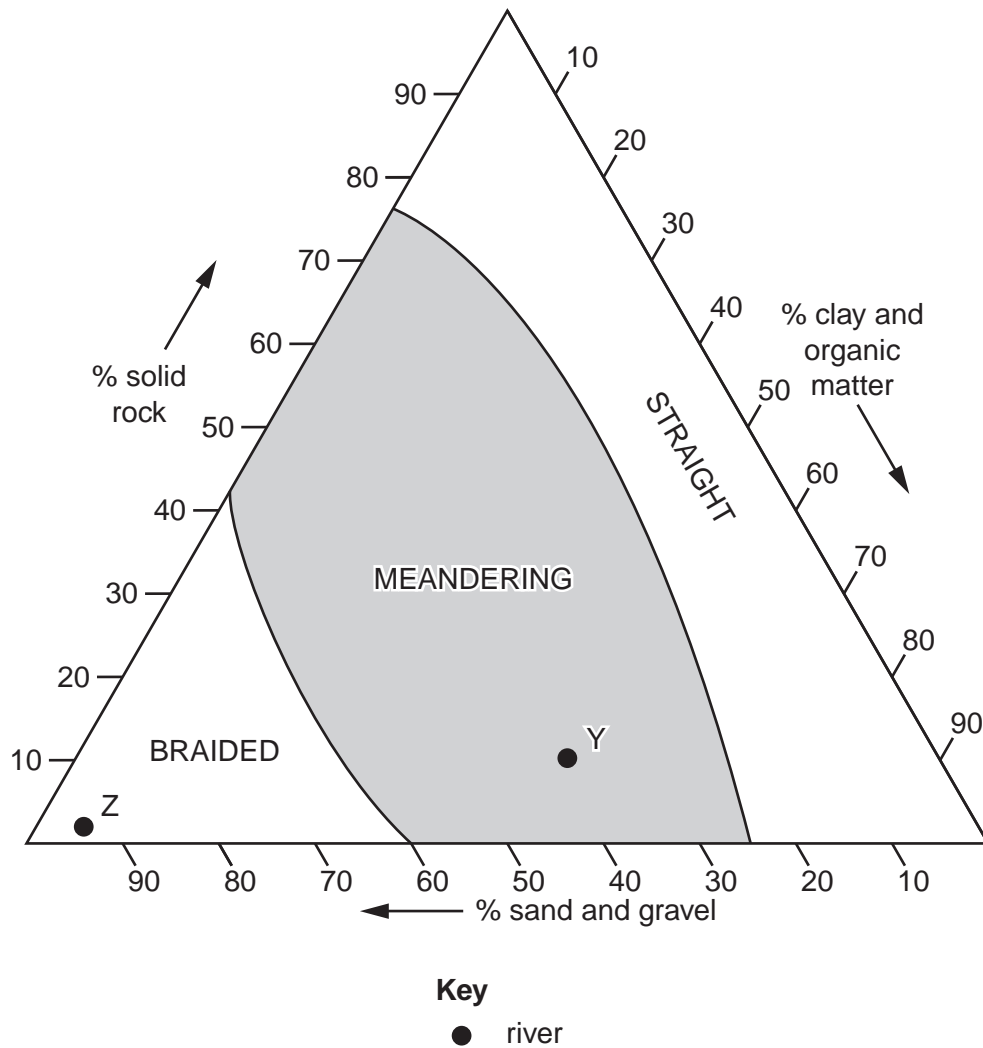
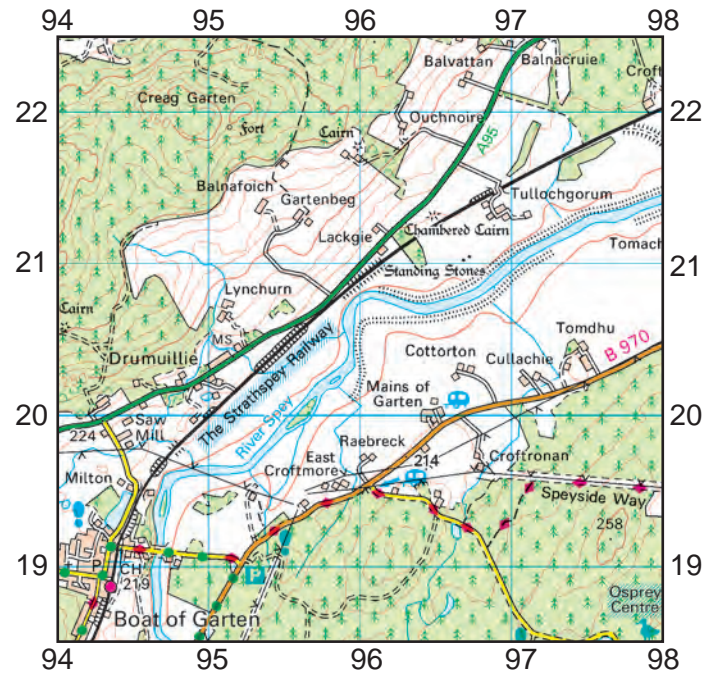

1:50 000 OS map extract of the River Spey, Scotland



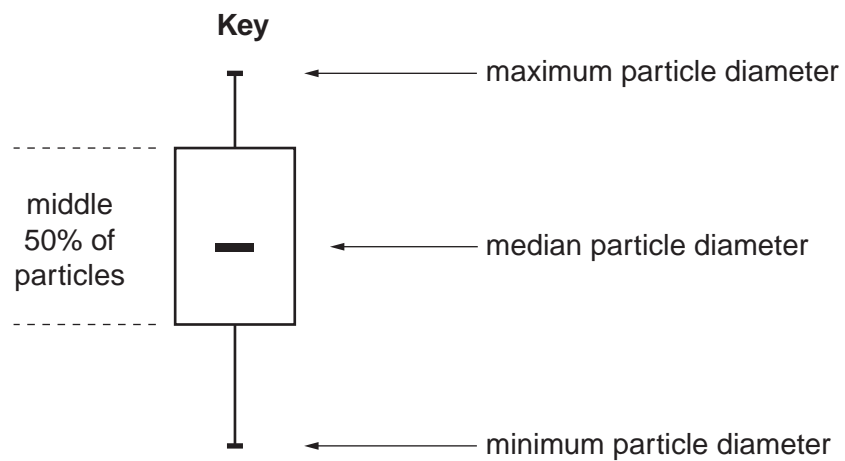
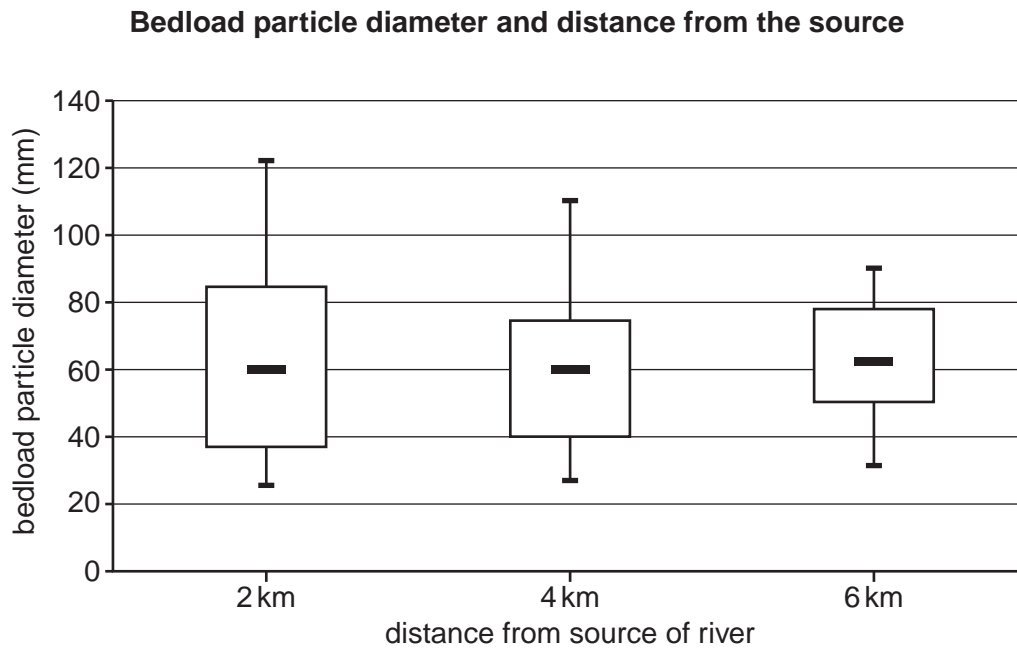

## Chloride and ammonium levels in groundwater surrounding a landfill site

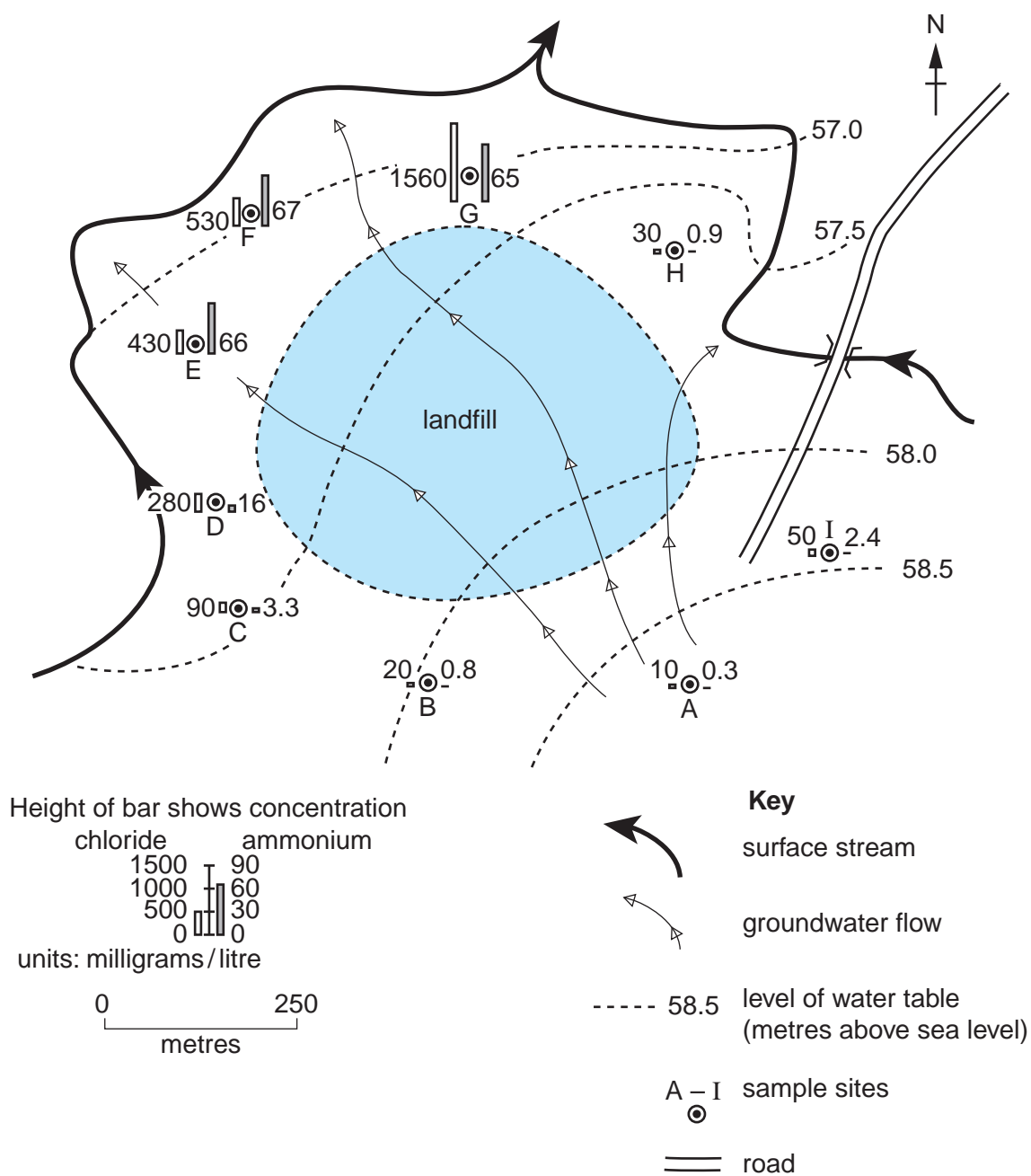

## The location of Beijing, China

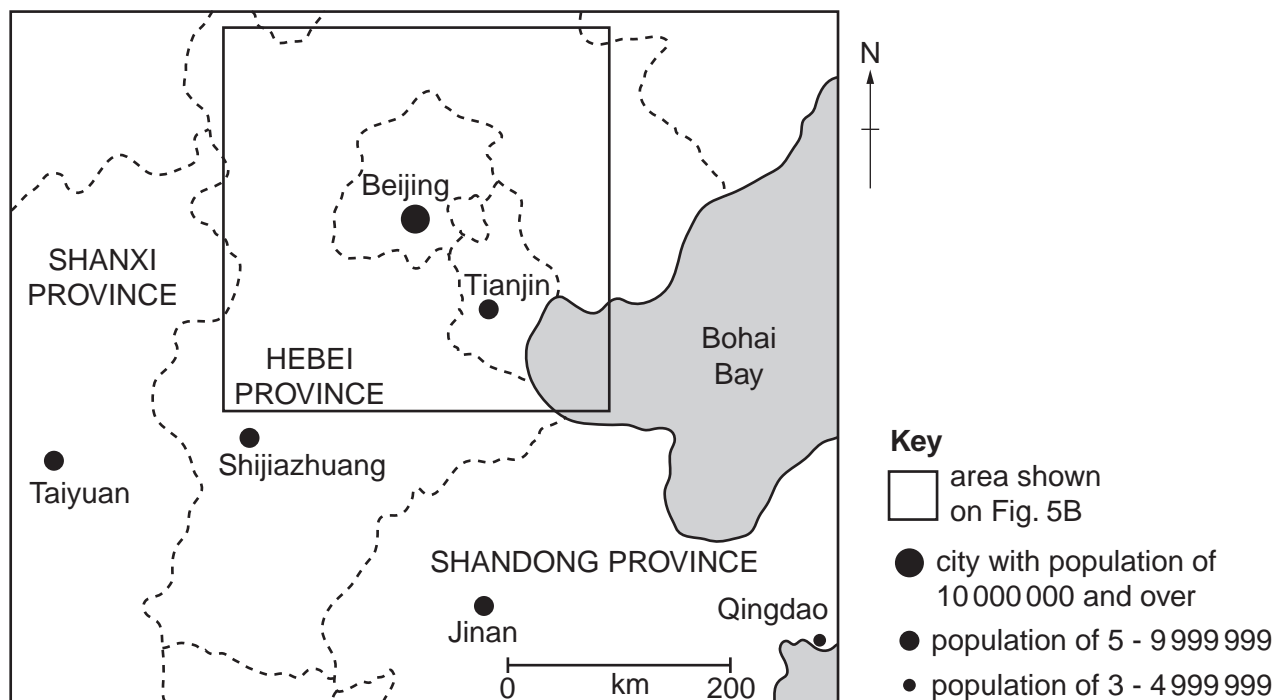

## Average concentration of fine particulate matter, July 2001

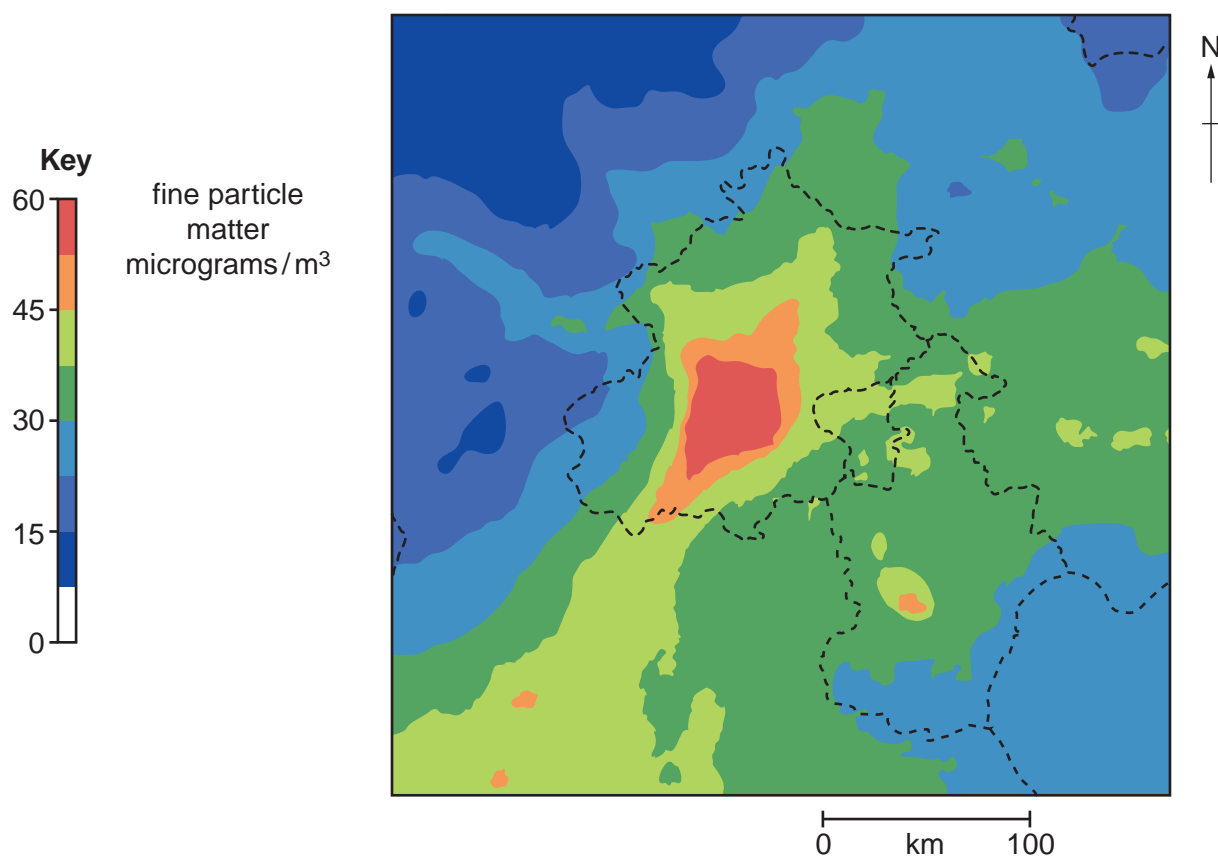
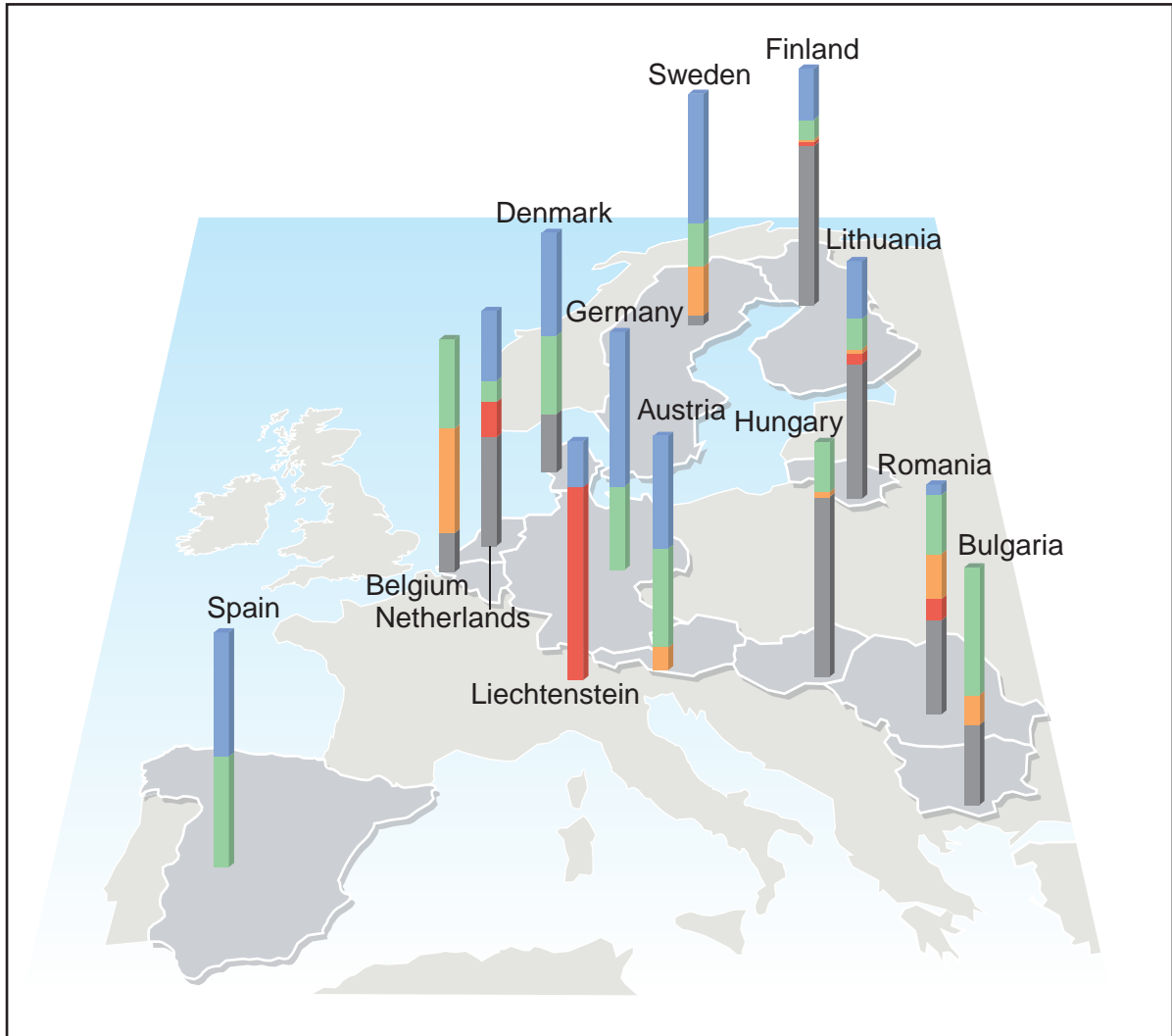
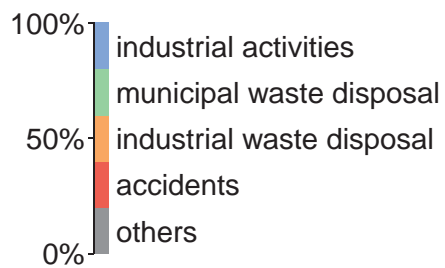

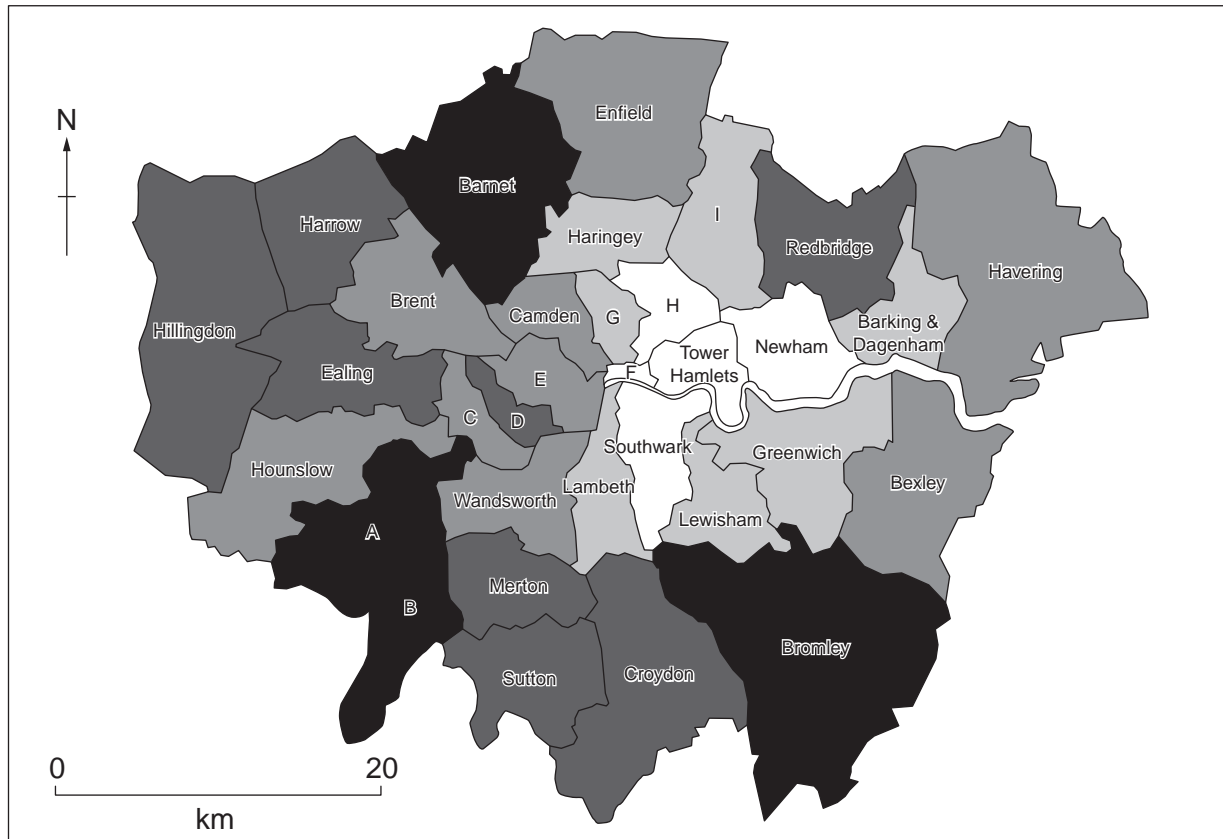

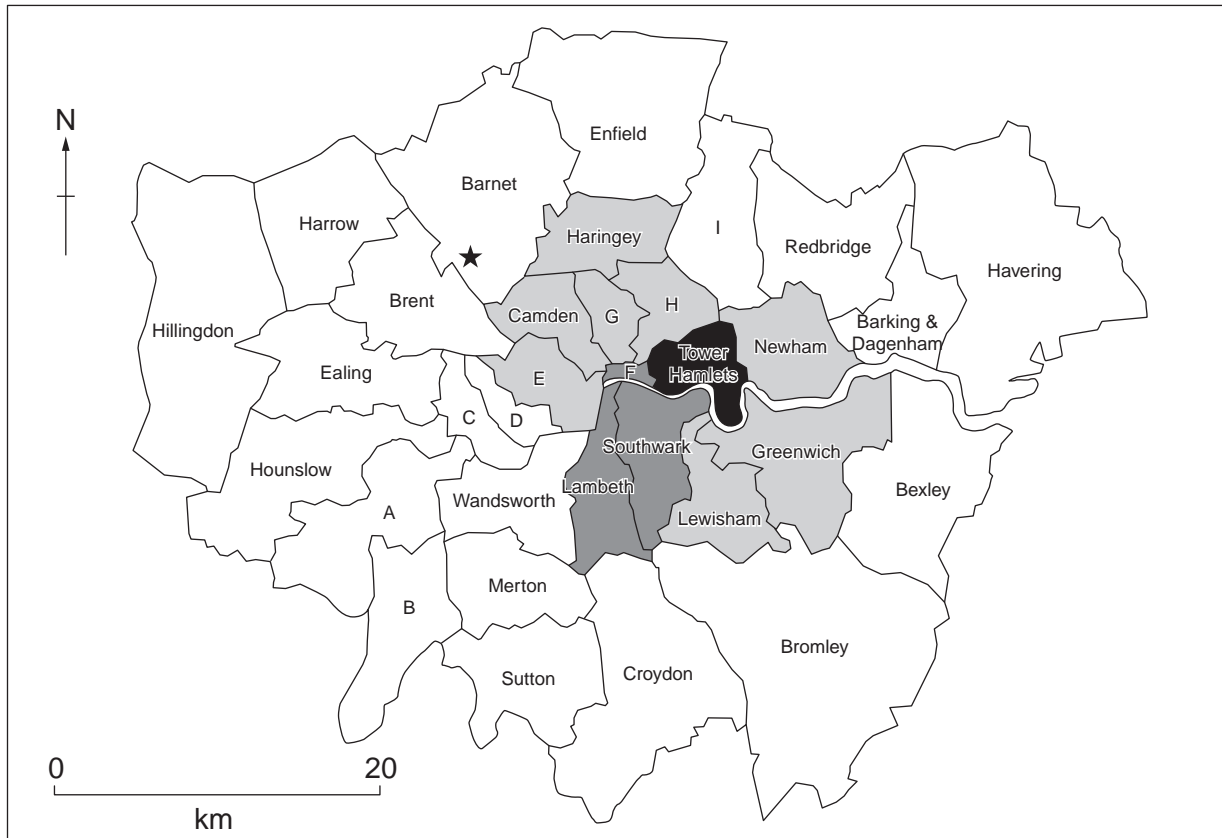

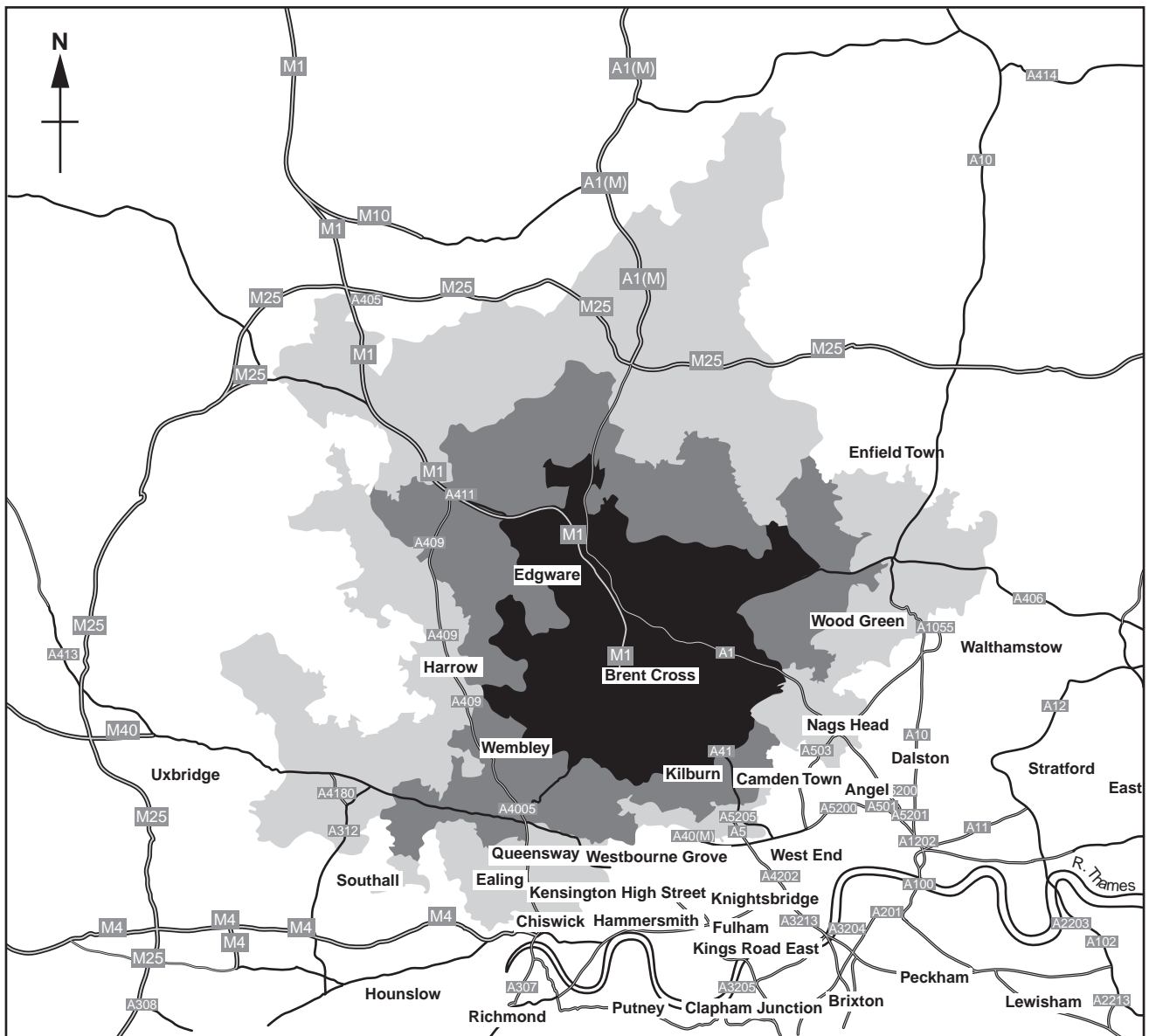
