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Introduction

Our examiners' reports are produced to offer constructive feedback on candidates' performance in the examinations. They provide useful guidance for future candidates.

The reports will include a general commentary on candidates' performance, identify technical aspects examined in the questions and highlight good performance and where performance could be improved. The reports will also explain aspects which caused difficulty and why the difficulties arose, whether through a lack of knowledge, poor examination technique, or any other identifiable and explainable reason.

Where overall performance on a question/question part was considered good, with no particular areas to highlight, these questions have not been included in the report.

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Unit 1 series overview

Entries for the January 2022 series were the highest ever, exceeding those of January 2019 and almost four times the level of January 2021.

General comments on the paper

Outcomes were pleasing overall, with the mean almost at the same level as in January 2019 which was the highest ever for a January series.

Learning Outcome 4 had particularly strong answers this series.</p>
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Learning outcome 1: questions 2, 3, 8, 13-15, 18, 23 and 29

This LO covers knowledge of hardware components and performance was generally strong. LO1 is one of the weightier LOs within the unit and as a result centres should spend more time with their learners developing knowledge around types of computer systems, networks, connectivity methods, topologies, network protocols, computer components, devices and fault diagnosis. Candidates performed well in all LO1 questions and did particularly well regarding access permissions for data stored on the cloud and knowing the protocol for sending and receiving files over the Internet.

Learning outcome 2: questions 1, 9, 19-21, 24-25, 28, 31 and 35

Performance on this LO was good overall; particularly given this is the heaviest weighted LO within the unit. Candidates found two questions more challenging, one which asked them to identify an image (which was a database), while the other asked for which terms described an app but not an application. Candidates did very well on questions asking what task could be carried out on a spreadsheet, what application would be used to view websites and whether a multi-platform game could run on more than one device.

Learning outcome 3: questions 4, 7, 17, 27, 33-34 and 39-40

The focus of LO3 builds on LO1 and LO2 and requires learners to demonstrate knowledge of how to install and upgrade hardware and software. Performance was good overall, with candidates performing particularly well on the question asking whether it is the responsibility of an employee to report anything unsafe. Candidates did not perform as well on the question about what shouldn't be included in a user acceptance test plan (a list of peripherals).

Learning outcome 4: questions 6, 10-12, 16, 22 and 36-37

Performance on this LO was the strongest of all, with learners demonstrating excellent knowledge of social media and security. Particularly strong performances were seen in questions about features of social media and business networking sites, naming a disadvantage of online shopping and the best form of communication for sending a long letter with related files (email). Candidates did not perform poorly in any LO4 questions.

Learning outcome 5: questions 5, 26, 30, 32 and 38

This LO carries the lowest weighting in the unit and performance of candidates was good. The LO is holistic in nature and draws together the learning from the unit to reflect on the practical uses of IT within business. The lowest outcomes were for the question asking what would be good practice when creating a presentation (they had to pick three out of five options). The highest performance was for the question linking three types of communication with relevant descriptions.

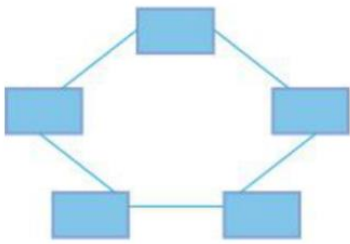
