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## Introduction

The reports will also explain aspects which caused difficulty and why the difficulties arose, whether through a lack of knowledge, poor examination technique, or any other identifiable and explainable reason.

Where overall performance on a question/question part was considered good, with no particular areas to highlight, these questions have not been included in the report.

### General comments on the paper

Questions for this computer-based test addressed a breadth of knowledge across the specification learning outcomes. Some learning outcomes were better understood than others. Based on the statistics for the individual items in the cloud technology multiple choice test, candidates overall were most successful answering questions targeting LO1: Understand the characteristics & context of cloud technology and why it is used and LO7: Know about impact, risks, and security issues related to cloud technology. LO4: Understand the features of cloud storage and LO3: Understand the requirements of cloud services, were the hardest to answer.

### Learning outcome 1: questions 1-15

This LO requires candidates to understand the characteristics and context of cloud technology and why it is used.

Questions targeting this LO had a positive response, with many candidates achieving the marks on Questions 1, 8, 9, 10, 12 and 13 and few candidates achieving the marks for Questions 7 and 14. In particular, Questions 2 and 3 were challenging for students.

## Learning outcome 2: questions 16-26

LO2 requires candidates to understand the business benefits of cloud services.

Candidates did well on Question 18, 24 and 25 but found Questions 19-21 and 23 challenging.

## Learning outcome 3: questions 27-47

LO3 requires candidates to understand the requirements of cloud services.

Questions for this learning outcome that presented difficulties for candidates were Questions 28, 29, 34, 36-38, 41-46. For Questions 27, 31 and 47, most candidates achieved the marks.

## Learning outcome 4: questions 48-53

LO4 requires candidates to understand the features of cloud storage.

There were six questions which addressed this learning outcome. Responses to Questions 51, 52 and 53 were the least successful.

## Learning outcome 5: questions 54-64

This LO requires candidates to understand the deployment requirements for cloud-based services for organisations.

Questions 55-59 and 63 were answered well with Questions 54, 60-62 and 64 being less successful.

## Learning outcome 6: questions 65-67

LO6 requires candidates to know the regulatory issues that impact cloud technology.

There were just three questions targeting this learning outcome. Responses to Questions 65 and 66 were often incorrectly answered.

## Learning outcome 7: questions 68-70

LO7 requires candidates to know about impact, risks and security issues related to cloud technology.

Of the three questions addressing this learning outcome the majority of learners were able to answer correctly.

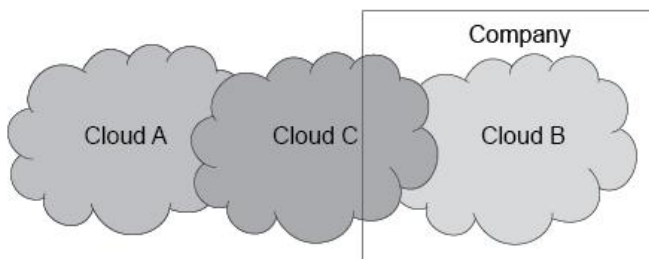

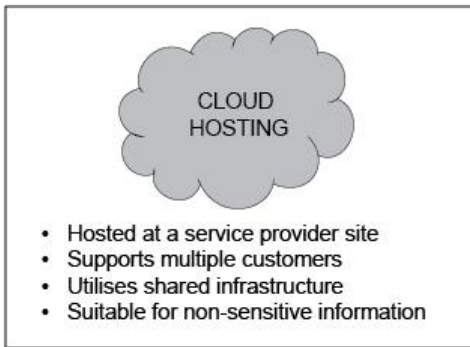

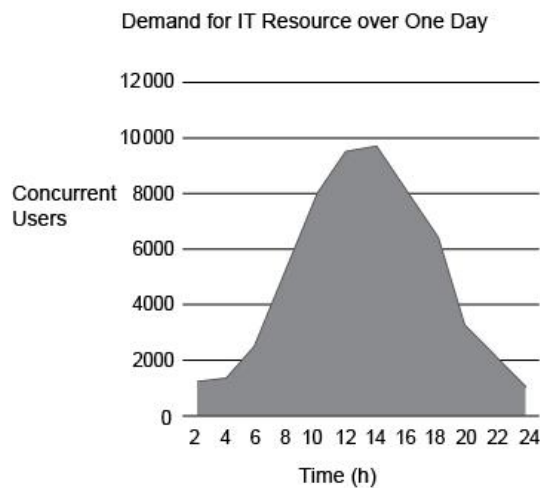

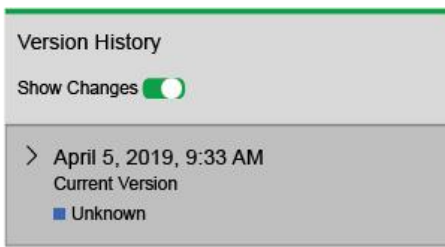
