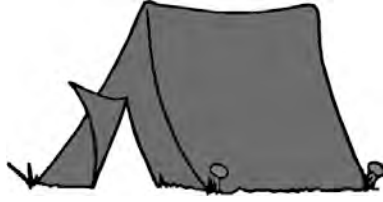

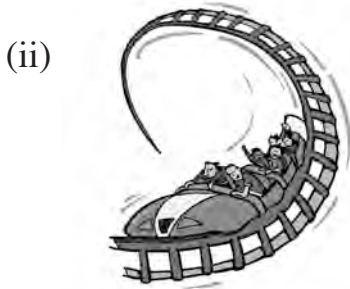



In just one day you can:-

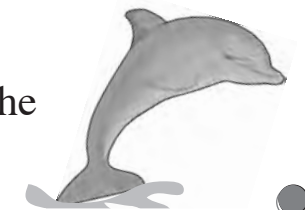
-  take a trip to see the dolphins and seals
