- producing a presentation.

## Section A

You must use the internet for this section only.

### Task 1 – Windsurfing

Stefan wants some information about windsurfing for a presentation.

Open **ResponsesSet20L2**

Enter your name, candidate number and centre number.

- (a) Use an internet search engine to find an image of a windsurfer.

Take a screen shot of the search engine showing the criteria you used and the results of the search.

Paste the screen shot into **ResponsesSet20L2**

Complete the table in **ResponsesSet20L2**

- (b) Windsurfing became a summer Olympic sport for women in 1992.

Use the internet to find:

- the city where the 1992 Summer Olympics were held
- the name of the woman who won the windsurfing gold medal in the 2012 Olympics.

Complete the table in **ResponsesSet20L2** with your answers.

## Section B

### Task 2 – Income

**IncomeSet20L2** contains the number of customers booked for each sport throughout the year.

Open **IncomeSet20L2**

Enter your name, candidate number and centre number in the footer.

- (a) Calculate the **Income** for each sport for January. (2)
- (b) Calculate the **Total income** for January. (2)
- (c) The target income per month is stored in cell **B23**  
Stefan wants to know if the target was met each month.  
Use a spreadsheet function to display 'Met' if the **Total income** was equal to or greater than the target and 'Not met' if it was not. (3)
- (d) Replicate the formulae for each sport for each month. (2)
- (e) Format the spreadsheet:
- format all currency values to show £
  - add any other formatting so that it is consistent, clear and easy to understand. (2)

- (f) Filter the spreadsheet to show **only** the information for the months when the **Total income** was more than £11000

Save the filtered spreadsheet as **High Income**

- (g) Use your filtered list to create a suitable chart to show the total income for each month.

Format the chart so that it is clear and easy to read.

Save the chart as a separate worksheet within **High Income**

### Task 3 – Presentation

Stefan wants a presentation to advertise the beach sports on offer.

The presentation must:

- have a title slide and **three** other slides
- be fit for audience and purpose
- be clear and easy to read.

It must include:

- relevant text selected from **SportSet20L2**
- the information you found in **Section A, Task 1(b)**
- the logo from **ImagesSet20L2** on all slides
- the image you found in **Section A, Task 1(a)**
- **two** other suitable images selected from **ImagesSet20L2**

Create the presentation.

Enter your name, candidate number and centre number in the footer.

Save the presentation with a meaningful name in your test folder.

*A copy of your presentation saved in your test folder.*

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#### **Task 4 – Prepare an email**

Identify **two** actions Stefan could take before the presentation is published.

- (b) Stefan tries to print your spreadsheet, but nothing happens.

He has checked that the printer is switched on.

Give **two other** checks he could carry out to try to resolve the problem.
