The hotels have been making a profit for the past five years and continue to satisfy their guests due to the extensive upgrading policy which takes place every five years. Huntmore plc also provides employment for many people who live in each of their locations. It is also important to Huntmore plc that it does not position another one of its hotels within a 35 mile radius of any of the other hotels within the group.

Huntmore plc wish to develop the business further by opening a specialised Pet Hotel for the two locations awaiting expansion. Research carried out by the group has concluded that there is a demand for such facilities in Northern Ireland.
