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Introduction

GCSE Arabic Writing is assessed by an examination at the end of the course of study. Questions are set in common contexts, addressing a range of relevant contemporary and cultural themes. They are organised into five themes, each broken down into topics and subtopics. The five themes are: Identity and culture, Local area, Holiday and travel, School, Future aspirations – Study and work, and International and Global Dimension. The assessment tasks feature general content that is familiar and accessible to all candidates. Candidates are required to produce responses of varying lengths and types to express facts, ideas and opinions in Arabic. The length of each response required and complexity of language increases across the paper. Recommended word counts are specified for each question. Candidates will not be penalised for writing more or fewer words than recommended in the word count nor for going beyond the mandatory bullet points. All questions are marked against the assessment criteria as published in the current specification. The instructions to candidates are all in Arabic. The use of dictionaries is not permitted. The examination for paper 4H is 1 hour and 25 minutes in length and it carries 60 marks.

The paper consists of two open response questions and one translation from English into Arabic. Candidates are required to answer all questions.

Q01 has two options, from which candidates have to select one. This question assesses candidates on their ability to convey information, narrate, express opinions, interest, or convince the reader about a certain point. Candidates must use the informal register. This question is common to the Foundation tier.

Q02 has two options, from which candidates have to select one. This question assesses candidates on their ability to convey information, narrate, express and justify ideas and opinions, and interest or convince the reader. Candidates must use the formal register.

Q03 is the translation question. Candidates are required to translate a short paragraph from English into Arabic. The individual sentences are ordered by increasing level of difficulty.

Question 1 (a)

This question had the theme of Identity and Culture and the topic of Cultural life. Candidates were given four bullet points within the context of an informal email about joining an online book club created by a friend. The question had to be answered using present, past and future time frames.

This question was less popular than Q01(b).

The vast majority of answers were well done with most scoring in the top two bands. Those who scored well showed a good understanding of the bullet points and gave opinions which they could justify. It was clear that candidates had been taught well to answer this style of question and most answered the points in equal length. The first two bullet points were done well with many using the perfect tense to give an opinion in answer to the second bullet point. For the third bullet point, some candidates found it difficult to say why Youcef must read the same story and why. A few wrote in excess of 90 words. These tended to be the more able candidates. However, unfortunately more mistakes were made towards the end of the piece, which became self-penalising. Knowledge of past and future tenses was generally sound. There was a high level of language used in most answers with the occasional idiom.

This response receives 12 marks for Communication and Content. The candidate has written information relevant to all four bullet points. The candidate expands the key points and ideas. There is a variety of language used to express ideas and opinions, with some examples of uncommon language. The register and style are appropriate. This response receives 8 marks for Linguistic Knowledge and Accuracy. The candidate produces some extended sentences frequently, which are linked using لأن and لأني . The language is generally accurate and includes successful references to past, present and future events. Occasionally, errors occur that do not hinder clarity of communication.

Question 1 (b)

The theme of this question was Identity and culture and the topic of Who am I. Candidates were given four bullet points within the context of an informal letter to your cousin about advice on where to buy domestic animals and why it is important to look after them. The question had to be answered using present, past and future time frames.

This question was more popular than Q01(a).

Most candidates seemed to enjoy describing their pets and writing about their experience in answer to the second bullet point, which they did very well. Some candidates gave a very good answer to the third bullet point, explaining the difficulties of getting a pet. However, some candidates found the third bullet point quite challenging. Knowledge of past and future tense was generally sound. There was a high level of language used in most answers with the occasional idiom. In the less good attempts, there were basic mistakes in tenses, and complex language was inaccurate.

Question 2 (a)

This question had the theme of Local area, holiday and travel and the topic of Holidays. Candidates were given four bullet points within the context of writing to the manager of a hotel to clarify their opinion about coastal resort. They had to write 130 - 150 words. The question had to be answered using present, past and future time frames.

This question was less popular than Q02(b).

There was a good number of candidates who answered this question very well. They entered into the spirit of the task by using persuasive language, which was most pleasing.

This response receives 16 marks for Communication and Content. The candidate has written detailed information relevant to all four bullet points.

The candidate develops their points and ideas effectively. They adapt the language they use to narrate, inform, interest and convince the reader of their ideas and points of view. There is a wide variety of vocabulary and expression with many examples of uncommon language. The register and style are appropriate.

This response receives 12 marks for Linguistic Knowledge and Accuracy. The response is fluent with extended, well linked sentences using a variety of structures.

The language is consistently accurate and includes consistently successful references to past, present and future events. Any errors do not hinder the clarity of the communication.

This response receives 5 marks for Communication and Content and 4 marks for Linguistic Knowledge and Accuracy. This candidate communicates some information but not all bullet points are addressed. There is some effective language and creative language to express individual thought. The structures are mostly straightforward with occasional complexity and some successful references to past, present and future events, but errors hinder clarity of communication.

Question 2 (b)

This question dealt with the theme of school and the topic of school activities. There are four bullet points to be responded to within the context of writing a formal letter to the headteacher to convince him/her about the idea of inviting an Arab celebrity that you have chosen. Candidates had to write 130 – 150 words. The question had to be answered using present, past and future time frames.

This question was more popular than Q02(a).

Candidates were seemingly well prepared for this question, both in terms of how to tackle the bullet points and the theme of school. There was quite a lot of creativity within such a formal question, which was refreshing. Most candidates attempted the first two bullet points well, finding different reasons for each. Several candidates were passionate about the Arab celebrity and that was lovely to read about.

There were some lovely idiomatic expressions. A good number of candidates had learnt introductory phrases and complex opinions that were used to good effect along with some very complex vocabulary that some very able candidates produced. This made their scripts pleasant to read and should be generally encouraged.

This response receives 9 marks for Communication and Content and 6 marks for Linguistic Knowledge and Accuracy. This candidate communicates detailed information with effective development of key ideas. Whilst there are irrelevant parts, all bullet points are fulfilled. The language is consistently effective with examples of creative and uncommon language to express individual thoughts. There is a wide variety of grammatical structures including complex language, and it is consistently accurate.

Question 3

This question addressed the future aspirations, study and work and the topic of ambitions. Candidates had to translate a passage from English into Arabic. There were some excellent attempts at this question showing good knowledge of vocabulary as well as higher level constructions and some were quite accurate. Many candidates omitted 'senior citizens' and 'medical charity'. There was much paraphrasing elsewhere too. However, the words 'hospital' and 'holidays' were well known.

Paper Summary

Based on their performance on this paper, candidates are offered the following advice:

- read every question on the exam paper before you begin to write your answers;
- look very carefully at the whole question, including the rubric, to make sure that you understand fully what you are being asked to do;
- look for key words in the bullet points because these will help you to answer each of the bullet points correctly;
- use vocabulary and language structures that you have learned, which are related to the topic about which you are writing;
- answer each of the bullet points in order, using a new paragraph for each one;
- leave enough time to check your work carefully at the end of the exam.

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
