 Exemplar Student Marked Work: Writing Spring 2012



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Introduction

The flexible, unitised structure of Unit 4 Writing allows students to maximise achievement. There are 50 marks allocated to this unit and the test carries 25% of the total marks.

Students are required to write, in Bengali:

a short list or to complete a form, which demonstrates their ability to write words or phrases. (Question 1)

a text, which offers the opportunity to use a variety of structures, expressing their personal opinions. (Question 2)

a text which offers the opportunity to write descriptively or imaginatively, expressing and explaining ideas and points of view, eg an article, a letter, publicity material. (Question 3)

Purposes for Question 2 and for Question 3

Students are offered a choice of contexts and purposes for Question 2 and for Question 3:

Question 2 (a) is drawn from the context Lifestyle; 2 (b) is drawn from Work and Education. Students answer either 2 (a) or 2 (b).

Question 3 (a) is drawn from the context Leisure; 3 (b) is drawn from Home and Environment. Students answer either 3 (a) or 3 (b).

Students must have access to a dictionary in the Writing test.

Stimuli are displayed in Bengali with gist summaries in the rubrics and suggested content points, all in English.

There is no word limit to either Question 2 or Question 3. It is important that the tasks are completed: the number of words need not be counted. Students are expected to use a variety of structures and include different tenses.

In Question 2, students are expected to express personal opinions and need to refer to at least two tenses in order to score top marks.


In Question 3, students are expected to express and explain ideas and points of view and to refer to three tenses.

The bullet points provided in Questions 2 and 3 are not prescriptive. Students do not have to respond to these bullet points fully. Instead, they may include their own ideas and points of view within the context of the question.



Student 1 Commentary

Question 1

The task is to convey 4 items which could be packed in a school bag, in Bengali. Three items are conveyed unambiguously, so 2 marks are awarded.

Total mark = 2

Question 2 (a)

This piece of work is fully relevant and very clearly communicated. The response is detailed and contains a lot of information. Ideas and points of view are expressed and explained in all paragraphs.

They are well justified by the student, for example: "হাঁটাচলা আর ব্যায়াম করলে শরীলে রক্ত চলাচল হবে। শরীর ভালো থাকবে। তোমর শরীর ভালো থাকলে তোমার মন ভালো থাকবে। তাইলে লেখাপড়ায় মন বসবেণ The response is also well structured, i.e. divided into clear paragraphs.

Content - 14

The student uses a wide variety of appropriate vocabulary. There are several examples of more complex sentences used successfully. Present, past and future tenses are all used on at least one occasion. Therefore, a mark of 5 is awarded.

Range of Language - 5

The response is accurate. Although there are several spelling errors and lapses, they are of a minor nature and do not affect communication. The intended meaning is clear in all sentences, therefore, a mark of 5 is awarded.

Accuracy - 5

Total marks = 24/24

Question 3 (b)

The response to the task is rather limited. Some relevant information is conveyed but not sufficient to score more marks. The piece would also benefit from improvements to the structure, which would make it clearer. The student begins by saying where she lives and where she lived before, she also linked where she would like to live in the future. This is followed by an opinion and reasons. However, the ideas could have been developed further, with more detailed information, hence a mark of 10 is awarded.

Content - 10

There is some variety of vocabulary, but the structure used is mostly simple. The student tries to use longer sentences, using appropriate linking words but the attempts are not always successful. There are attempts to use different tenses but they are in mostly simple structures. Therefore, a mark of 3 is awarded.

Range of Language - 3

The piece contains many errors of spelling, punctuation and grammar but, on the whole, they do not impede communication. Verb forms are sometimes successful but occasional lapses impede appropriate communication. Therefore, a mark of 2 is awarded.

Accuracy – 2

Total marks = 15/24

Student 2 Commentary

Question 1

The student gives 4 items which could be packed in a school bag. The words are unambiguous, so a mark of 2 is awarded.

Total marks = 2

Question 2 (b)

The content is fully relevant to the task. The information is communicated clearly, explaining ideas and points of view. The structures are also appropriate, varied and well organised. Complex structures are handled with confidence and the verb/tense forms are used successfully.

This piece of work is fully relevant and very clearly communicated. The response is detailed and contains a lot of information. Ideas and points of view are well expressed and justified by the student using conditional and habitual past. For example: 'আমি ইংরেজি ক্লাবে যাই কারণ আমার ইংরেজি এত ভাল না; আমি যখন বাংলাদেশে ছিলাম তখন এত ক্লাবে যেতাম না। শুধু খেলাধূলার ক্লাবে যেতাম, আমার খেলাধূলা খুব ভাল লাগে; ক্লাবে গেলে অনেক বন্ধু বান্ধবীও পাওয়া যায়; ক্লাবে গিয়ে যদি কিছু শিখা যায় তাহলে ভবিষাতে কাম আসতে পারে।

The examples above show that the piece contains varied structures and fits well within the context, though all suggested points have not been fully developed. In particular, the points on possible improvements to the current range of school clubs were not covered. However, teachers should bear in mind that students do not have to respond to all the suggested bullet points. They may include their own ideas and points of view instead. The overall content comfortably fits in the top band of 'Very good', therefore, the highest mark of the top band (14) is awarded.

Content - 14 marks

The student uses a variety of appropriate vocabulary and varied structures. There are several examples of more complex sentences used successfully. Present, past and future tenses are all used on at least one occasion. More complex sentences are handled with confidence and verb tenses are used successfully, so 5 marks are awarded for Range and Language.

Range of Language – 5

The response is largely accurate, although there are some errors (wrong spelling, for example: শিকা, কাম,একন, সবছে) particularly in attempts at more complex structures. However, they are of a minor nature and do not affect communication. Verbs and tense formations are also secure. Therefore, 5 marks are awarded for Accuracy.

Accuracy - 5

Total marks = 24/24

Question 3 (b)

This piece of work is fully relevant and very clearly communicated. The response is detailed and contains a lot of information. Ideas and points of view are expressed and explained in detail.

They are well justified by the student, for example: 'আমার লন্ডনের বড়ি আমার কাছে ভালো লাগে না কারণ লন্ডনের বাড়ি খুব ছোট আর যেদিকে তাকাই শুধু বিলডিং আর বিলডিং; খুব বেশি গাড়ির শব্দ। গাড়ির শব্দের জন্য রাতে একটু শান্তিতে ঘুমাতে পারি না।. The response is well structured and sequenced very well. The overall content comfortably fits into the top band of 'Very good'; therefore the highest mark of the top band (14) is awarded.

Content - 14

The student uses a wide variety of appropriate vocabulary. There are several examples of more complex sentences used successfully. Present, past and future tenses are all used on at least one occasion, there is a range of language and wide variety of appropriate vocabulary in evidence. The student deserves full marks in this category, so a mark of 5 is awarded.

Range of Language - 5

The response is accurate, and although there are several spelling errors, they are of a minor nature and do not affect communication. The intended meaning is clear in all sentences.



Student 3 Commentary

Question 1

There is some ambiguity on item 1 and item 2. However, items 3 and 4 are displayed unambiguously. It is to be noted that to score 2 marks, students need to convey 3 out of 4 words. Here, the student conveys 3 words appropriately. Therefore, a mark of 2 is awarded.

Total marks = 2

Question 2 (b)

The task requires the student to focus on the context of curricular and extra-curricular activities on offer and thoughts about a way forward. The student does not have to respond to each bullet point, so the messages conveyed are generally relevant. However, the information conveyed was not enough to score marks within the top two bands. The piece would also benefit from improvement to the structures and formation of verbs. The student offers simple opinions, and there is some development of basic ideas. However, they are not always explained or justified, hence a mark of 8 is awarded.

Content - 8

There is some variety of vocabulary but the structures used are mostly simple with heavy influence from regional dialectical expressions. The student tries to use longer sentences, using appropriate linking words but the attempts are often unsuccessful, with a frequent mismatching of verb forms. Therefore, a mark of 3 is awarded.

Range of Language -3

The piece contains many spelling, punctuation and grammatical errors, which often impede communication. Therefore, a mark of 2 is awarded.

Accuracy - 2

Total marks = 13/24

Question 3 (b)

The content again is fully relevant to the task. The information is conveyed clearly, explaining ideas and points of view. The structures are also appropriate, varied and well presented. Complex structures are handled with confidence and the verb/tense forms are used successfully. The suggested points have not all been covered. This is perfectly acceptable. Students do not have to respond to the suggested bullet points, as long as they have written a relevant and detailed response to the title and included their own ideas and points of view. The content fits well within the criteria of 'Very Good' and a mark of 14 is awarded.

Content - 14 marks

There is evidence of a variety of appropriate vocabulary and structures. More complex sentences are handled with confidence, such as আমার এলাকার জন্য কিছু করতে ইচ্ছে করে না। আমার বাড়ির কানদায় জিমও নাই এ কারণে আমার শরীর খারাপ হয়েছে।. The piece lies well within the top band and so the mark of 5 is awarded.

Range of Language - 5 marks

This piece is generally accurate. Verb and tense formations are also secure. However, a number of spelling errors are evident. Therefore, a mark of 4 is awarded.

Accuracy - 4 marks

Total marks = 23/24

- The mark awarded for Range of Language must not be more than one band higher than the mark awarded for Content. (See table below).
- The mark awarded for Accuracy must not be more than one band higher than the mark awarded for Content. (See table below)
- If a mark is awarded for Content, this will inevitably lead to the award of a mark for Range of Language and for Accuracy.
- If a mark of zero is awarded for Content, this will automatically result in a zero score for Range of Language and for Accuracy.
