Canteen & Caravan

The canteen at Haven High, has a wide range of choices when it comes to meal times, offering healthy and nutritional meals. At Break there is also a variety of foods to choose from for a snack.

With the meal that they purchase at Lunch your child is entitled to a free cup of orange juice, however this is only available at the canteen.

Each Lunch there is a selection of meals to choose from, and after there is always a pudding to choose from. Which can be served on its own, or maybe with custard.

Several years ago now, a new piece of technology was installed which gives a new way of paying for their food. They used to be given a card which they put money on and then use that to buy or dinner.

However now they use their thumb. Their fingerprint is taken at the beginning of the year, it is then saved. So when they go to buy their meal, you place their thumb on the sensor, and it comes up with their name. Of course like the cards they still need put money on their 'thumb' which will be taken away from their balance every time they buy a meal.

Not only is there a selection at the canteen there is also meals available at the caravan outside, located near English. The Caravan serves, hot meals or sandwich's. There is also a choice of cake which changes throughout the week. They also have drinks available that can be brought with their meal. And to add to this, they also sell fresh fruits such as apples or bananas.


At the caravan they are able to pay with cash, if they fancy a school meal that particular day.

Awards, rewards & Punishment

Rewards are given out to year groups for praise, for good behaviour, or excellent exam results or great attendance.

And the end of the year, or at the end of a term, there is an celebration Assembly where certificates and awards are given out to those that have been selected by teachers for doing great work, and their contribution in the class and during the year.

Recently a group of year 10's that have joined the Study & Support scheme went on a trip to Alton Towers, these rewards are given for excellent attendance, or great behaviour. At the end of Year 11, those that join the Study & Support scheme are given the chance to go to Butlins for 4 days.
