You are advised to spend about 45 minutes on this Section.

EITHER

- 1 Compare the ways poets reveal feelings in *Nothing's Changed* (page 6) and **one** other poem. (27 marks)

OR

- 2 Compare the ways poets suggest that belonging to a particular culture or cultures is important in *Presents from my Aunts in Pakistan* (pages 16 and 17) and **one** other poem. (27 marks)

SECTION B: WRITING TO INFORM, EXPLAIN OR DESCRIBE

Answer **one** question from this Section.

You are advised to spend about 45 minutes on this Section.

Remember:

- spend 5 minutes planning and sequencing your material
- about two sides of average sized handwriting should be enough
- spend 5 minutes checking:
 - your paragraphing
 - your punctuation
 - your spelling.

EITHER

- 3 Write a letter to a teachers' magazine in which you **inform** teachers about what life is really like for people of your age.

OR

- 4 Given a choice, who or what would you most like to be? **Explain** the reasons for your choice.

(27 marks)

OR

- 5 **Describe** a sinister street at night.

(27 marks)

OR

- 6 Choose something you feel strongly about. Write **informatively** about it and **explain** why you feel as you do.

(27 marks)
