OR

2 Compare the methods the poets use to explore the connection between people and the places in which they live in *Hurricane Hits England* (page 18) and **one** other poem. (27 marks)

SECTION B: WRITING TO INFORM, EXPLAIN OR DESCRIBE

Answer one question from this section.

You are advised to spend about 45 minutes on this section.

Remember:

- spend 5 minutes planning and sequencing your material
- about two sides of average sized handwriting should be enough
- spend 5 minutes checking:
 - your paragraphing
 - your punctuation
 - your spelling.
