You are advised to spend about 45 minutes on this section.

EITHER

1 Compare how language and layout are used for effect in 'Two Scavengers in a Truck, Two Beautiful People in a Mercedes' (page 8) with the ways language and layout are used for effect in **one** other poem. (27 marks)

OR

2 Compare the ways poets use description in 'from Search For My Tongue' (page 12) and **one** other poem. (27 marks)

SECTION B: WRITING TO INFORM, EXPLAIN OR DESCRIBE

Answer **one** question from this section.

You are advised to spend about 45 minutes on this section.

Remember:

- spend 5 minutes planning and sequencing your material
- about two sides of average sized handwriting should be enough
- spend 5 minutes checking:
 - your paragraphing
 - your punctuation
 - your spelling.

EITHER

Write a letter to a Minister for Education **informing** him or her of the things you think should be done to improve education for teenagers. (27 marks)

4 Choose a famous person whom you admire. **Explain** why you admire this person. (27 marks)

OR

5 Describe a dream world.

6 Choose an event from your past that has special significance for you. **Describe** what happened and **explain** how you feel about it. (27 marks)
