Section A Reading Poetry from Different Cultures

You are advised to spend about 45 minutes on this section.

Compare the ways the poet reveals feelings about a place in 'Nothing's Changed' (page 6) with the ways another poet reveals feelings about a place or places in **one** other poem. (27 marks)

How does the poet present conflict in 'Not my Business' (page 15)? Compare his methods with the ways conflict is presented in **one** other poem. (27 marks)

Section B Writing to Inform, Explain or Describe

Answer one question in this section.

You are advised to spend about 45 minutes on this section.

Remember:

spend 5 minutes planning and sequencing your material
about two sides of average sized handwriting should be enough
spend 5 minutes checking:

your paragraphing
your punctuation
your spelling.
