### 5 Deficiency in the Final Submission

Each candidate's final submission must include **three** pieces:

- One for the Extended Literary Text
- Two for Imaginative Writing (a main and a satellite task) from a choice of Personal and Imaginative Writing and Prose Fiction

If only one piece is completed for Imaginative Writing, this must be divided by two to get an overall mark out of 30 for Imaginative Writing. This then needs to be added to the mark for the Extended Literary Study to obtain a final mark out of 60.

If a candidate completes any work at all for the Controlled Assessment Unit then the work should be assessed according to the criteria and the marking instructions and the appropriate mark awarded, which may be 0 (zero).
