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INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE COMPLETION OF THIS FORM

PENALTIES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE OF SPECIFICATION

One art form more than 50%: Work will be marked as normal but cannot be marked higher than the highest mark in the *Basic* mark band for Objectives 1, 2 and 3.

Three contrasting art works not studied: For *two* art works studied, work will be marked as normal but no mark may exceed the top mark of the *competent* mark band for all objectives.

For *one* art work studied, no mark may exceed the top mark of the *Basic* mark band for all objectives. If *no* art works have been studied, no mark can be achieved, as the requirements of the specification have not been met.

Areas of study missed: The marking criteria should cover this eventuality. No marks would be available for candidates who had no evidence for any of the areas of study.
