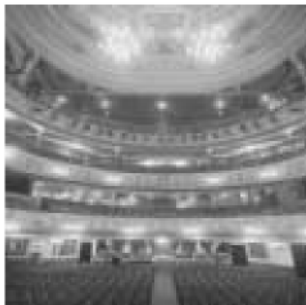

PASS (Level 4)

- To achieve a **Pass** (Level 4) in this piece of work you must give a minimum of **four** items of information, including at least one opinion. Each item should contain a different verb.

MERIT (Level 5)

You might like to include:

- the type of film(s) you watch;
- where you watch them;
- who you watch them with;
- when you watch them;
- what you like;
- your favourite actor/actress.

Add information about:

either a film you have watched recently,

or one that you would like to watch.

- To achieve a **Merit** (Level 5) in this piece of work you must give a minimum of **six** items of information, including at least one opinion. You should refer to the past **or** the future as well as the present. Each item should contain a different verb.

DISTINCTION (Level 6)

You might like to include:

- the type of film(s) you watch;
- where you watch them;
- who you watch them with;
- when you watch them;
- what you like;
- your favourite actor actress.

Add information about:

a film you have watched recently,

and one that you would like to watch.

- To achieve a **Distinction** (Level 6) in this piece of work you must give a minimum of **eight** items of information, including at least one opinion. You should refer to the past **and** the future as well as the present. Each item should contain a different verb.
