## SPEAKING AND WRITING CONTROLLED ASSESSMENTS

### SPEAKING UNITS A702, A712, A722

We are now able to provide further guidance regarding the Speaking controlled assessment tasks and how marks and candidate work will be submitted. There will be two tasks:

- **Task 1** – This will be recorded and moderated. The moderation samples can be submitted either via the OCR Repository or by Postal Moderation. The entry option you choose determines the method of submission.
- **Task 2** – This does not need to be recorded and only marks (rather than samples) need to be submitted. Any scaling calculated on the basis of performances of Task 1 will be applied on a pro-rata basis to Task 2.

Marks will need to be submitted for each task separately.

We enclose the revised pages of the *OCR Admin Guide and Entry Codes: 14–19 Qualifications*, which show the entry options.

### WRITING UNITS A704, A714, A724
