1	Is cuimhin liom go raibh mé mall ag dul chun na scoile an mhaidin sin. Lá fuar geimhridh a bhí ann agus bhí sé ag plúchadh sneachta.
2	Mar is eol duit, tá deirfiúr bheag agam nach bhfuil ach trí bliana d'aois – an duine is óige sa chlann. Bhí drochshlaghdán uirthi an deireadh seachtaine sin. Bíonn mo mháthair ag obair seal na hoíche cúpla lá sa tseachtain.
3	Agus ó tharla gur mise an iníon is sine, mise a fhágtar i mbun an tí nuair a bhíonn sí ar shiúl. An oíche áirithe sin, b'éigean dom fanacht i mo shuí go dtí a haon a chlog, rud a d'fhág iontach tuirseach mé an lá arna mhárach.

There is a variety of linguistic and structural features to support cohesion and overall coherence. The candidate has a very good command of idiom and vocabulary appropriate to this level. There are very few grammatical errors even where more complex language is used. Punctuation and spelling are very accurate.	17–20
4	The candidate communicates clearly and effectively, using and adapting forms and selecting vocabulary appropriate to task and purpose. There is a variety of linguistic and structural features to support cohesion and overall coherence. The candidate has a good command of idiom and vocabulary. There may be a few grammatical errors where more complex language is used. Punctuation and spelling are generally accurate.	13–16
3	The candidate communicates adequately, using and adapting some forms and selecting some vocabulary appropriate to task and purpose. There is some variety of linguistic and structural features to support cohesion and overall coherence. The candidate has some command of idiom and vocabulary but control is inconsistent. Grammatical errors are more frequent when more complex language is used but otherwise fairly accurate. Spelling and punctuation is adequate.	9–12
2	The candidate communicates to a lesser degree, selecting a limited vocabulary appropriate to task and purpose. There is less significant variety of linguistic and structural features to support cohesion and overall coherence. The candidate shows some command of idiom and vocabulary. There are frequent errors and inconsistent control of basic structures. Grammatical errors are more frequent. Spelling and punctuation errors are more frequent.	5–8
1	The candidate shows some ability to communicate; there is modest selection of vocabulary appropriate to task and purpose. There is slight variety of linguistic and structural features to support cohesion and overall coherence. The candidate has a modest command of idiom and vocabulary. There is a high frequency of grammatical errors and a modest control of basic structures. Punctuation and spelling errors are very frequent.	2–4
