2(b)(iv)	The candidate does not have to rewrite the question. Level 1 – The answer contains basic statements, largely a list, and probably taken directly from the diagram. Level 2 – a linked statement showing how the action would affect their lives. There are linked statements but not really showing the effect on the inhabitants' lives, but showing some clarity.
2(c)(i)	The candidate does not have to use actual words on the diagram.
2(c)(ii)	There is a linked statement showing why features contribute to sustainability. Unqualified pollution gets no credit.
