#### **SUMMARY OF KEY CHANGES**

### Unit A731: Contemporary Themes in Geography

In this new unit, there are three compulsory themes with content taken from the previous specification:

- Extreme Environments
- The Global Citizen
- Similarities and Differences in Settlements and Population.

#### **Extreme Environments**

- Content now forms Theme 1 content for A731 Contemporary Themes in Geography
- Content has been reviewed, with underpinning geography and level of detail to be taught made explicit.
- Polar environment has been removed. Schools must teach 'Hot Desert Environments' and 'Mountain Environments'
- Candidates continue to study one named hot desert environment and all candidates must now study one named non-UK Mountain environment
- Issue in our Fast Changing World has been integrated into this theme as 'Earthquake', where candidates study one recent earthquake event.

#### The Global Citizen

- Content now forms Theme 2 content for A731 Contemporary Themes in Geography
- Content has been reviewed, with underpinning geography and level of detail to be taught made explicit.
- Candidates continue to study one named product and one named service
- Issue in our Fast Changing World has been integrated into this theme as 'Energy' where candidates study one recent energy supply issue.

# Similarities and Differences in Settlements and Population

- Content now forms Theme 3 content for A731 Contemporary Themes in Geography
- Content has been reviewed, with underpinning geography and level of detail to be taught made explicit.

- Candidates continue to study one named local place in the UK and one named non-UK place (which must not be in a hot desert or mountain environment)
- Issue in our Fast Changing World has been integrated into this theme as 'Population Change' where candidates study one recent issue relating to population change.

#### Unit A732: Geographical Skills

- Skills list has been reviewed with level of detail to be taught made explicit
- Skills continue to be taught throughout the course
- Pre-release resources have been removed and the question paper will be based on a geographical scenario with unseen resources. The question paper will include a compulsory section on OS map interpretation.

#### CONTROLLED ASSESSMENT

- Controlled assessment has changed from two tasks of 1000 words each to one task of 2000 words, which must include the collection of primary data
- Centres can choose from a range of set task titles, the title most appropriate to their local settings and available resources. There will be two task titles available each year from the following aspects of geography: 'Issues linked to retail areas' and 'Issues linked to settlements and land-use'
- New mark scheme to use (section 4.3.4 in the specification)
- Previous content for controlled assessment unit A672 You as a Global Citizen has been moved into new unit A731 Contemporary Themes in Geography and will be examined. New content for controlled assessment unit A733 relates to the stages in completing a successful geographical investigation. The final piece of work completed by candidates can continue to be presented in a variety of formats.
