SECTION C: THE DECISION**Question 5**

The government of the island of St Lucia in the Caribbean plans to increase their income from tourism. The east coast of the island is not developed for tourism at the moment.

The Ministry for Tourism in St Lucia has to choose from **four** possible options for the future of tourism on the island. They want to develop tourism to its full potential while sustaining the natural and cultural resources of the island.

Option 1

Develop a series of big resort complexes on the east coast to attract large numbers of European and North American visitors.

Option 2

Develop a number of smaller beach resorts on the east coast to attract tourists mainly interested in water sports and other physical activities.

Option 3

Develop several small ecotourism areas on the east coast which will attract environmentally aware tourists.

Option 4

Develop the island's existing tourist areas further and do not develop the east coast at all.

Task

Explain which option you think would offer St Lucia the most sustainable way to increase income from tourism.

In your answer you should:

- State your chosen option
- Give the advantages and any disadvantages of your chosen option
- Explain why the option you have chosen is more sustainable than the others
- For one of your rejected options give **two** reasons why you rejected it and **one** possible advantage of this rejected option
