

## **Additional translation practice: German (Paper 4 – Writing)**

## Foundation Tier questions

## Foundation Tier mark scheme

The translation is assessed for Conveying key messages (5 marks) and Application of grammatical knowledge of language and structures (5 marks), as specified in the criteria below. The maximum mark is 10. When awarding the marks, the student's response across all five sentences should be considered as a whole.

#### Translation 1

#### Indicative content

#### Translation 2

#### Indicative content

I like going to the cinema.	Ich gehe gern ins Kino.
We have too much homework in English and Maths.	Wir haben/bekommen zu viele Hausaufgaben in Englisch und Mathe.
Your house has four bedrooms and a kitchen.	Dein Haus hat vier Schlafzimmer und eine Küche.
I played badminton last week with my brother.	Ich habe letzte Woche Federball/Badminton mit meinem Bruder gespielt Ich spielte letzte Woche Federball/Badminton mit meinem Bruder.

## Higher Tier mark scheme

The translation is assessed for Conveying key messages (6 marks) and Application of grammatical knowledge of language and structures (6 marks) as specified in the criteria below. The maximum mark is 12. When awarding the marks the student's response across the passage should be considered as a whole.

Mein Hobby ist Kochen und ich esse immer gesund. Deshalb werde ich im Ausland arbeiten. Ein Hotel oder Restaurant wäre gut. Ich möchte das tun, wenn ich achtzehn Jahre alt bin.

## Translation 2

Last week I lost my mobile phone in town. I need it in order to do my homework and now I cannot download music. My father has said that I must buy a new one. I have no money, so I will find a job in a supermarket. That would be useful.

### Indicative content

The following indicative content is an example of a response which would be awarded full marks.

Letzte Woche habe ich mein Handy in der Stadt verloren. Ich brauche es, um meine Hausaufgaben zu machen und jetzt kann ich Musik nicht herunterladen. Mein Vater hat gesagt, dass ich ein neues kaufen muss. Ich habe kein Geld, also werde ich einen Job in einem Supermarkt finden. Das wäre nützlich.
