- **After the two role plays you will do a Presentation, for about one minute, on a subject you have prepared.**
- **The rest of the Speaking test will consist of a Discussion of the Presentation with your teacher, and finally, two General Conversation topics.**

SECTION 1

- 3 ask where it is
- 4 ask the cost

SECTION 2

SITUATION: You are at a friend's house in Germany. One morning you feel ill and stay in bed. Your teacher will play the part of your German friend and start the conversation.

You will have to:

- 1 say what is the matter with you
(e.g. don't feel well / headache / stomach ache)
- 2 answer the question
- 3 say what you ate OR drank last night
- 4 say what you want to do
(e.g. stay in bed / go to the doctor's / take tablets)



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
