- **The important thing in the Section 2 role play is to convey the message.**
- **You must not make any written notes during the preparation period before the examination.**
- **For your Presentation you may take into the examination room a cue card with up to five short headings on it. No other written notes are allowed.**
- **No dictionaries are allowed.**
- **After the two role plays you will do a Presentation, for about one minute, on a subject you have prepared.**
- **The rest of the Speaking test will consist of a Discussion of the Presentation with your teacher, and finally, two General Conversation topics.**

DIE FAHRT IN DIE STADT

Wann abgefahren? Wie? people getting into a car

Wo geparkt? Wann? large building with sign 'Parkhaus'

EINKAUFEN

Wohin gegangen? Warum? town centre

Was gekauft? building with sign 'Kaufhaus'; clothes; books; MP3 player; jewellery

Billig? Teuer? money

DAS MITTAGESSEN

Wohin? Warum? restaurant

Was gemacht? meals – burgers, fish, chips, steak, cake, hot and cold drinks

DAS PROBLEM

Wohin? large building with sign 'Parkhaus'

Autofenster kaputt – warum? car window smashed

Was gestohlen? coat, handbag, money, MP3 player, radio, CDs

SPÄTER AUF DER POLIZEIWACHE

Wohin gegangen? three people at a counter with sign 'Polizei'

Was gefunden? police officer with thief and bag; in the bag – coat, handbag, money, MP3 player, radio, CDs

Glücklich? Warum? sad or happy face?

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
