- improvements you will make to your room.



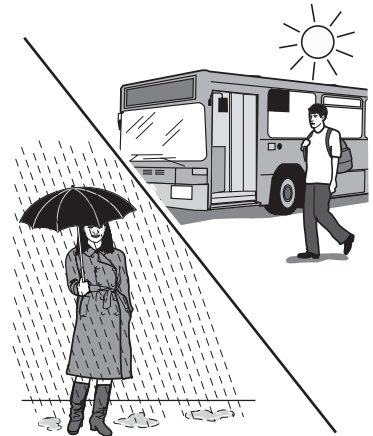
