Intellectual – unable to think clearly, not able to perform tasks that they normally can, unable to make decisions easily Emotional – self-doubt as a mother, poor communication skills, feeling of not being able to cope. Worry/stress. Isolated. Conflict with daughter. Disempowered Social – afraid of meeting people, reclusive, poor communicator. Socially isolated.

Everything is too hard, therefore there is only failure to look forward to. Lacking in confidence. Sees herself as weak/stupid/worthless Stressed Social isolation
