### A Roman Public Bath

This picture is an artist's reconstruction of the Roman baths at Brampton in Norfolk. Brampton was a small village 2 miles up river from the sea on the east coast of England. Brampton was important for trade and metal working. The site of the baths is now ploughed land.

### Two American Government Health Campaign posters

In 2004 the American Government began a campaign to reverse the trend to obesity in the population because of its health consequences. Obese or overweight Americans made up 64% of the population in 2002. The total health cost of this problem to the USA was \$117 billion. The campaign targeted 'family-builders', aged 25-49, representing 36% of all Americans.
