1335 Paper 01 and Paper 02

I am writing to inform you of some changes to the format of the above question papers. For the summer 2007 examination, 1335 paper 01 and paper 02 will be marked online. Although the requirements and demands of the question papers remain unchanged, there are some changes to the format of the papers so that they can be marked online by examiners. The changes are as follows:

- 1335 paper 01 and paper 02 are now a question and answer booklets. All questions must be answered in the booklet. If candidates require additional space for any question, they must use additional sheets and fasten them to the booklet, using treasury tags, at the end of the examination.
- Each page has a box around the edge. Candidates must not write outside this box.
- There is a discrete answer space for each answer and candidates should indicate, using the cross-boxes within the question paper, which questions they are answering. Instructions are provided in the question paper.

I would like to take this opportunity to remind you that detailed information about the performance of your candidates in the units that are marked on line, after results have been issued, can be accessed by using the services available through the Edexcel website.
