- The Trades Union Congress organised a national strike in 1926

4. How important was religion as a factor leading to the increase of accusations of witchcraft in the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries? Explain your answer.

- Before the Reformation, the Church dealt with accusations of witchcraft
- Bad harvests at the end of the sixteenth century led to great poverty and unemployment
