

Source 9:

Hitler's view of the failure of the Beer Hall Putsch. He was speaking in 1933.

It was good fortune for us Nazis that the Putsch collapsed because:

- Take-over of power in the whole of Germany would have led to the greatest difficulties in 1923. This is because the essential preparations had not even been made by the National Socialist Party.
- The events of November 1923 have proven to be the most effective propaganda for National Socialism.
