


Individual Task



Domilyn likes animals especially dogs and fish. She does not like cows though.


Physical Development


Domilyn is able to walk, run and do lots of physical activities, especially climbing. She jumps around and walks on tip-toe. She can also undress herself.

Domilyn tells you when she needs the toilet and goes by herself or sits on her potty.



Domilyn knows her name and tells you;







Emotional Development





what is physical development?

- By the age of 30 months a child should;


- * jump

- * thread beads.






what is social development?

 - * Engages in parallel play.






what is intellectual development?


It is the development of the mind. (mental development)

- They learn about people and the world around them.


By the age of 30 months a child should be able to;


- * Notice detailed pictures.
