



- VISIT FIVE: I will observe Demilyn dressing / undressing to see how Demilyn copes with buttons and ties. How long it takes will depend on Demilyn.








All my activities are inside except for throwing and catching



- A ball that will be outside but I will overcome that by using a smaller ball inside if it rains.


If Demilyn will not co-operate or if any of us are ill, I will reschedule my visit because I will be able to visit Demilyn as often as I want.









The time of the visit was tea-time on 30th September, it took place other parents house, it lasted about 40 minutes.







Throwing and catching a ball.



Demilyn handles her cutlery very well for her age. When she came to the sausage her mum had already cut it up but she still picked it up with her fingers.


Demilyn was quite unsettled towards the end, I think it was that she wanted to play.



This observation took place at Demilyns house.




Demilyn was very hyperactive because she had just visited her cousins.

We sang twinkle twinkle little star because it is Demilyns favourite and was the first on the tape.


Demilyn was jumping up and down and pointing at the sky, because Demilyn liked that one.










Activity	Does Demi use a pencil properly?	Does she use her hands steadily?	Does she use her hands rapidly?




This visit took place at my house because Demilyn was sleeping the night. Demilyn was in a good mood and she'd just been to sleep so she was fully aware of what I was asking her.


Demilyn does not hold a pencil properly but she manages.








I visited Demilyn about 10:00am on 30th October, the visit took place at her house.






Dressing/Undressing


The visit took place at Demilyn's house, I had to go at 10.00am because I had to catch Demilyn getting ready.

Overall Demilyn is very good at caring by herself except for ties. Demilyn co-operated very well, I think that was because it was a daily thing.






