









The relationship between me and Demilyn





evaluation

First of all I collected background information on Demilyn about where she lived, her surroundings and her likes and dislikes.

I chose physical development for my topic to study because I knew Demilyn would like the activities involved, more than the ones involved in the other developments.

My visit (first) was quite easy going because I have always seen Demilyn regularly. The more visits that took place the easier they got because Demilyn was use to them.

I think everything went well as Demilyn cooperated with all the activities, but if I had to do it again I would use a video recorder to record the visit. Instead of using a table because I could watch it back while I recorded my results.



From my observations of Demilyn I have found out that she can throw a ball, but could not catch it with two hands. She prefers to use her fingers when eating, she is not keen on using a fork, she enjoyed the nursery rhymes and actions activity, she cannot use a pencil very well and she ^{can} undo buttons, but not fasten them.

Demilyn is about average development looking at my research in the Task Analysis.

I should have done at least one more visit and including more detail in my planning section. My reasons for choice center have been better. I did not mention any books in the understanding, although I have used P. Minett for my research.

My methods of recording my observations worked well with the photos, drawings by Demilyn and the charts I drew up.




