Answer one of the following:

EITHER, TASK 1

Fashion designers may seek inspiration from historical or cultural sources.

Design and make an item of clothing, or an accessory, for yourself or a child using one of these sources.

Interior designers may seek inspiration from historical or cultural sources.

Supportive Work – Guidelines

Your supportive work should show evidence of interpretation, research and investigation, including ICT where appropriate. The development of ideas should be clearly recorded, with reasons for selection and rejection at each stage. You may draw on work accomplished during the course. It is recommended that your work is limited to 10 sides of A3 paper or its equivalent (approximately 3000 words).

Include evidence of the following:

(a) interpretation and investigation; [10]

(b) selection and development of ideas; [10]

(c) planning and techniques; [12]

(d) evaluation of your work. [8]

NOTE:

Before finalising your choice of item, consider that it is suitable for posting to the moderator. You are advised not to include costly or fragile items that have sentimental value.
