

# GCSE ICT Short Course When can the units be assessed?



You now have choices on when you can assess each unit. Below are three options you may like to consider.

#### Option 1 – Want to sit the exam first?

June 2011 Or complete in January 2012	June 2012	Advantages
Unit 1 – Exam  40%  40%	Unit 2 – Controlled Assessment 60%	<ul> <li>Get the exam mark banked</li> <li>If a student did not perform well they could re-sit the exam in either January or June 2012 and the best exam mark will count towards the qualification</li> <li>Have more time to do the controlled assessment unit</li> </ul>

### Option 2 – Want to get all of the Controlled Assessment completed first?

June 2011	January 2012 Or complete in	June 2012	Advantages
Unit 2 – Controlled Assessment 60%	Unit 1 – Exam 40%	Unit 1 – Exam 40%	<ul> <li>Get the Controlled Assessment mark banked</li> <li>Students have the opportunity to re-sit Unit 2 alongside the exam in June 2012</li> <li>Students have the opportunity to re-sit Unit 1 in June 2012 however, due to the 40% rule, the re-sit mark will count towards the qualification</li> </ul>

#### Option 3 – Want to do all the assessment at the end?

June 2011	January 2012	June 2012	Advantages
N/A	N/A	Unit 1 – Exam Unit 2 – Controlled Assessment 100%	Do the assessment all at once     Have more time to prepare

#### Assessment Overview

**Unit 1 – Exam 40%** 

Unit 2 – Controlled Assessment 60%

- Can only certificate in June 2012
- There will be one assignment for Unit 2 and it will change every year

#### 40% Rule:

At least 40% of the assessment must be taken at the end of the course
