The Working Environment

When starting up a business, entrepreneurs may experience difficulty with cash flow as they may not have the expertise to cope with all the financial aspects of the business.

Entrepreneurs may have to hire more workers. They may interview various applicants in order to assess their suitability for the job as well as finding out what sort of person they are.

The successful applicants may require training in order to motivate them in their work which could lead to increased sales for the business. However, employees may require time off from their work to participate in training programmes and this may cause problems for the business when meeting deadlines.
