## RESOURCE 1

### How to Find Us

The Alton Towers Resort is slap bang in the middle of the country with excellent transport links for both road and rail. Our nearest stations are Stoke-on-Trent, Derby and Uttoxeter, and we are in between the M1 and the M6.

### By Car

The Alton Towers Resort is situated in a beautiful part of the country, in the Staffordshire Peak District, and many of the approach roads are narrow, single track, and twist through small villages.

We ask our guests to please show respect for our neighbours and the environment by not speeding or driving aggressively. There are many walkers, cyclists and horse riders in this area and we would like to ensure the safety of all road users.

For satellite navigation reference, the postcode for Alton Towers Resort is **ST10 4DB**.

Please set your sat-nav to stick to “main routes” or “fastest”, not “shortest” which may end up taking you no further than a farm!



### By Public Transport

Towers Resort is served by some great public transport links with main line train stations at Derby and Stoke-on-Trent being the easiest to access.

Uttoxeter is a branch line station which has connecting trains to Derby and Crewe. The Alton Towers Transport team run a number of bus services designed to connect with incoming train services from popular destinations, and if you buy your Theme Park ticket on board the bus (on-the-day prices apply), not only will it save you having to wait at the entrance when you arrive, but you'll also get your bus trip free!
