

## Principal Moderator's Comments

### **Brief 6 – An extract from a new television programme (The Knights Chamber – in the style of Dragons Den)**

**Overall portfolio mark 96/120:**

**Production component 50/60 Level 4**

The production is a sample of group work, and is fairly typical of the standard expected for a level 4 mark.

There is evidence of suitable production values. The research and planning has informed the production work, indicating an inventive application of the appropriate conventions along with a sense of audience.

The other evidence presented in the portfolio would have included:

- individual Research & Planning (including comparative and audience studies); and
- an individual Evaluation (including assessments of how the original brief was met, monitoring & revisions, how prior research had informed decisions, audience feedback, use of forms and conventions).

*NB. In cases of group work (as opposed to individual submissions) the evidence available to moderators is partial – only the teacher can know, and therefore assess the contributions of group members. If the other parts of a candidate's work (Research & Planning, and the Evaluation), which are completed individually, are assessed fairly and appear consistent with the Production component, a moderator can have confidence in the teacher assessment of the practical work. As in all cases of practical and/or group work, different candidates will have demonstrated varying strengths and weaknesses in each aspect of the assignment. Thus an overall mark total could be gained in a variety of ways.*

*The teacher assessment and comments are vital in enabling moderators to validate the marks given.*
