- Emphasis on Games (Invasion; Net/Wall; Striking/Fielding/Target) • Emphasises effective and safe performance • One tier only
- in Games
- · Co-teachable with PE
- · Short course in Games also available

WHAT CHANGES ARE THERE FROM THE OLD SPECIFICATION?

- · Detailed specification aims relate more closely to assessment objectives
- Assessment objectives tracked through the assessment process
- Specification content and questions are more directly related to participation and performance
- Duration of guestion papers has changed: - Physical Education and Physical

- Education: Games = 1 hour 45 minutes - Physical Education: Games (short course) = 1 hour
- Effective performance is now marked out of 25 for each activity
