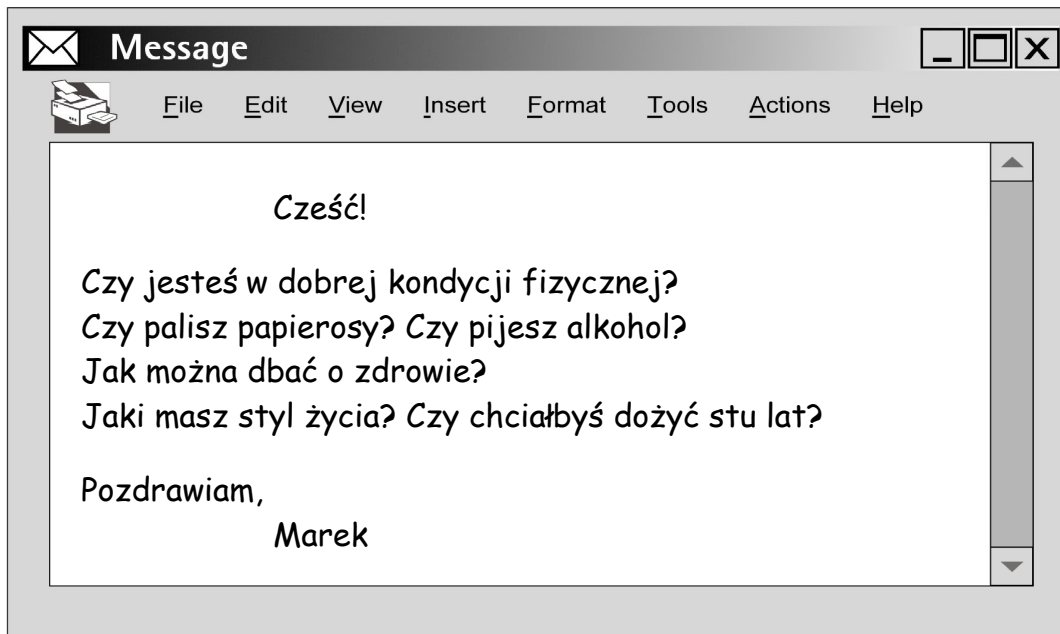

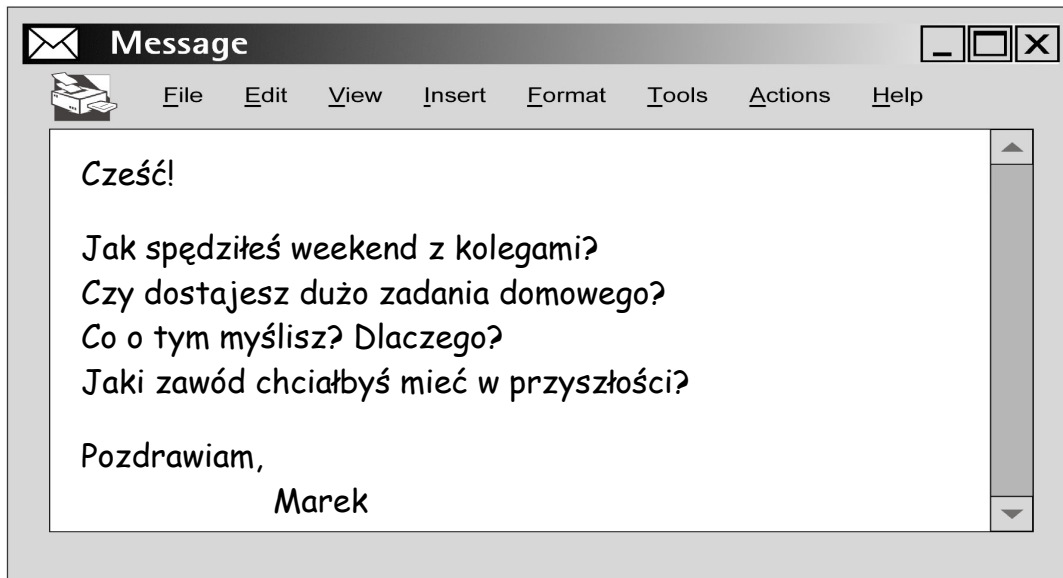
Reply to Marek's email in **Polish**, giving your views and the reasons for your opinions. For example, you **could** talk about the following:

- 3 (a) You see this letter in a magazine about a daughter whose mobile phone takes the place of her teddy bear. She sends 1000 texts a month, downloads ring tones and wallpapers, and uses it to take photographs and make videos at school. The mobile gives her parents a feeling of security, but they are now worried that she is over using it.
