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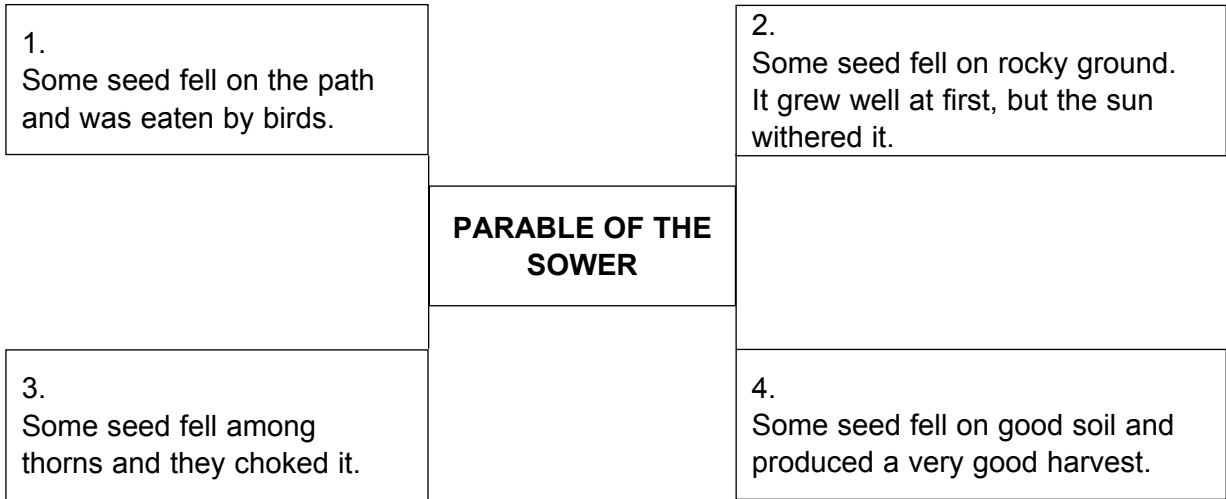

**C7** (c) ‘Pilate was totally to blame for Jesus’ death.’
