Do you agree? Give reasons for your answer, showing that you have thought about more than one point of view. Refer to Mark's Gospel in your answer. *(6 marks)*

B5 (c) Jesus mixed with tax collectors and sinners. Explain why this is important. *(6 marks)*

B5 (d) 'Jesus had no right to clear the Temple.'

Do you agree? Give reasons for your answer, showing that you have thought about more than one point of view. *(6 marks)*

Do **not** answer Question B6 if you have answered Question B5.

B6 Jesus' Suffering, Death and Resurrection

B6 (a) Give an account of the anointing at Bethany. *(6 marks)*

B6 (b) 'Jesus did not need to pray in Gethsemane because he knew he had to die.'

Do you agree? Give reasons for your answer, showing that you have thought about more than one point of view. *(6 marks)*

B6 (c) Describe what the women saw and heard when they visited the tomb of Jesus. *(6 marks)*

B5 (d) "The women went out and fled from the tomb. They said nothing to anyone, because they were afraid." This is not a good ending to Mark's Gospel.'

Do you agree? Give reasons for your answer, showing that you have thought about more than one point of view. *(6 marks)*
