- (b) Your Russian link school has asked you to write an article about holidays. Write the article, explaining how you prefer to travel and giving reasons for your preference. Describe your last holiday, including how you travelled, and your plans for the next holiday.

Sport, leisure and work:

- (c) Write a blog for a Russian-language website entitled "A Healthy Lifestyle". Say what you think a healthy lifestyle is, what you have done in the past to be healthy and what you intend to do in the future.
- (d) Write a Russian-language article for your Russian link school about an event that you helped to organise. Say what the event was and what you thought of it. Describe an event that you are planning for the future.
