Key Changes: Unit B673 - Applying Sociological Research Techniques

Draft Specification	Final QCA-accredited Specification
Candidates are required to conduct a sociological enquiry into a topic area specified each year by OCR.	Candidates will be provided with pre released material that will take the form of two case studies, both focusing on the same topic (as specified in the specification).
Candidates are examined on the process of preparing the topic for study, applying different methods and evidence to investigate it and then drawing conclusions from the data	Candidates are examined on their understanding of the case studies. Candidates may be required to make comparisons between the two investigations provided. They are expected to understand and use sociological concepts and terminology that are relevant to sociological research.
