

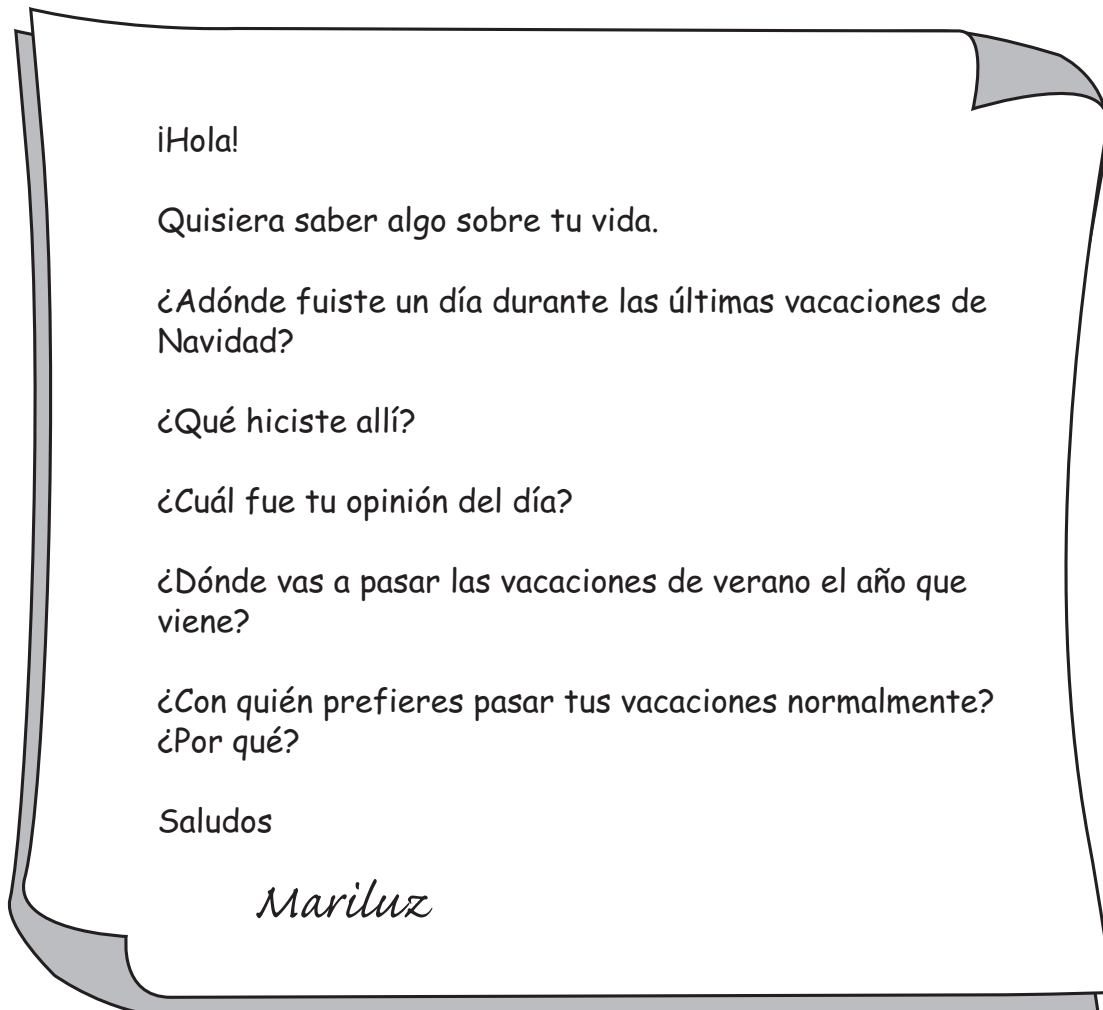
2 You receive the letter below from Mariluz, your friend in Tenerife.
