

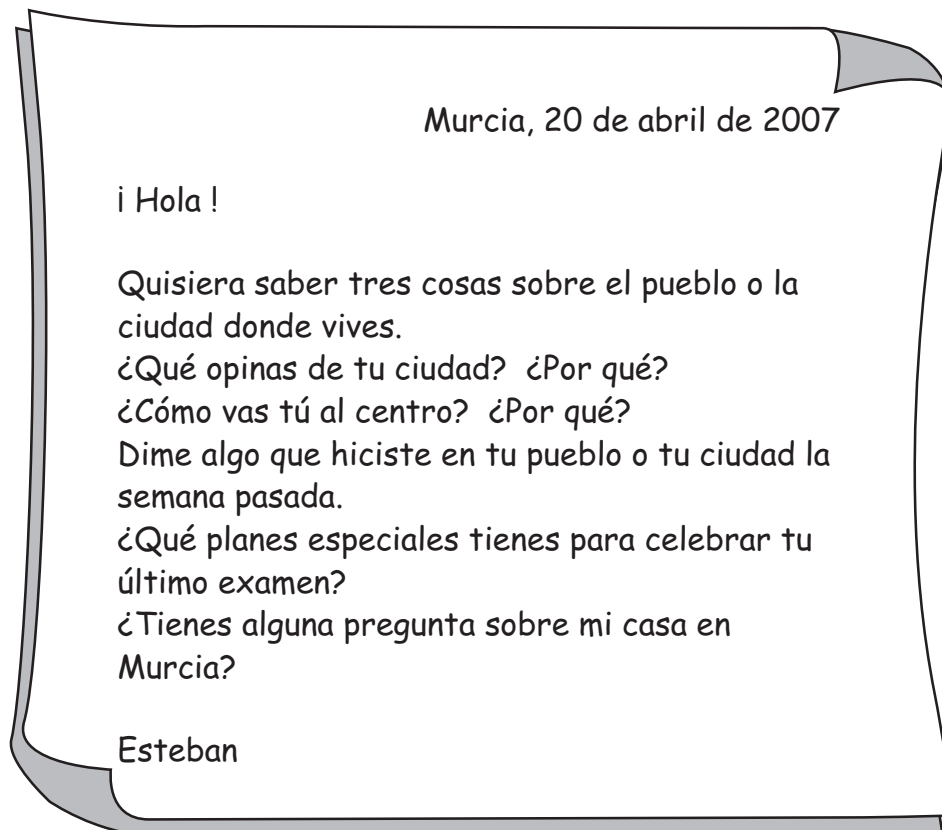
- 2 You have just received a letter from your Spanish penfriend, Esteban, in Murcia. You reply to him, answering his questions and asking one of your own.
