INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

- You must carry out the tasks specified in the situations overleaf.
- The roles to be played by you and your teacher are indicated.
- You have about 10 minutes to study the situations.

- The important thing is to convey the message.
- You must not make any written notes during the preparation period before the examination.
- For your Presentation you may take into the examination room a cue card with up to five short headings on it. No other written notes are allowed.
- No dictionaries are allowed.
- After the two role plays you will do a Presentation, for about one minute, on a subject you have prepared.
- The rest of the Speaking test will consist of a Discussion of the Presentation with your teacher, and finally, two General Conversation topics.



Section 1

Situation A passer-by in Spain asks you for directions to the Town Hall.

Your teacher will play the part of the passer-by and start the conversation.

You will need to:

- 1 say where it is (e.g. on the right / on the left / straight ahead)
- 2 say at nine o'clock
- 3 say five minutes away
- 4 say by bus

Situation You are talking to a Spanish friend about your job last summer.

Your teacher will play the part of the friend and start the conversation.

You will need to:

- 1 say you worked in a restaurant
- 2 give two details about the uniform (e.g. trousers and a shirt / black trousers / red tee-shirt etc)
- 3 answer the question
- 4 say you want to work this year







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ROLE PLAY CARD 2

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
Section 1

Situation You go into a café in Chile.

Your teacher will play the part of the waiter / waitress and start the conversation.

You will need to:

- 1 order a hot drink (e.g. coffee / tea / chocolate)
- 2 choose a sandwich filling (e.g. ham / cheese / spicy sausage)
- 3 say you like the café
- 4 ask for the bill

Situation You are interested in studying in Costa Rica. You telephone a college there. Your teacher will play the part of the secretary and will start the conversation.

You will need to:

- 1 say you want to study Spanish
- 2 give your name and age
- 3 say you visited Spain last year
- 4 answer the question







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ROLE PLAY CARD 3


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Section 1

- 3 ask the price
- 4 ask where the beach is

Situation You are in a shop in Peru.

Your teacher will play the part of the shopkeeper and start the conversation.

You will need to:

- 1 say you want to buy a tee-shirt
- 2 mention two details (e.g. colour / size / design)
- 3 say you arrived yesterday
- 4 answer the question

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
Section 1

Situation You are in a grocer's shop in Spain.

Your teacher will play the part of the assistant and start the conversation.

You will need to:

- 1 ask for a fruit (e.g. oranges / apples / pears)
- 2 say a kilo
- 3 ask for something else (e.g. ham / cheese / water)
- 4 ask the price

Situation You are at a theme park in Spain.

Your teacher will play the part of the employee and will start the conversation.

You will need to:

- 1 say you have lost your brother / sister
- 2 describe him / her. Give two details (e.g. short / dark / blue eyes etc)
- 3 answer the question
- 4 say you want to speak to your parents

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Section 1

Situation A Spanish friend phones you during your stay in Spain.

Your teacher will play the part of your friend.

You start the conversation.

You will need to:

- 1 answer the phone
- 2 ask your friend how he / she is
- 3 suggest somewhere to go (e.g. cinema / swimming pool / beach)
- 4 say seven o'clock

Situation You are talking to a Spanish friend about your studies.

Your teacher will play the part of the friend and start the conversation.

You will need to:

- 1 say you want to study history
- 2 say you worked a lot last year
- 3 mention two subjects you don't like (e.g. English / geography / chemistry)
- 4 answer the question

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
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
