

## CONTROLLED ASSESSMENT TEACHER SUPPORT SHEET

### 'Where do the wealthiest people live?'

Class discussion should allow an open forum for students to discuss how they can develop a testable hypothesis for the above question.

Students will need to decide what hypothesis to pursue based on the data that are available.

Terms to be defined:

- **Where** – areas of the ward, town, county, country of the UK (Sampling to be done on a geographical basis using one of – Google Earth, [http://image.guardian.co.uk/sys-flash/Guardian/flash/2007/07/17/map\\_UK\\_richpoor2.swf](http://image.guardian.co.uk/sys-flash/Guardian/flash/2007/07/17/map_UK_richpoor2.swf) (copy and paste this link into the URL of your web browser), or an atlas)
- **Wealth** – how could/should this be measured? (household income, ownership of cars, rooms per house, etc)
- **Live** – main residence in the UK
