**Theseus abandons Ariadne and sails away while she is asleep.**

ὁ Θησεὺς ἐφίλει τὴν Ἀριάδνην, ἀλλὰ οὐκ ἤθελε  
φέρειν αὐτὴν εἰς τὰς Ἀθήνας. ἐπεὶ οὖν ἐκάθευδεν  
ἡ Ἀριάδνη, ὁ Θησεὺς τοῖς ἐταῖροις· “σίγατε, ὦ φίλοι”  
ἔφη· “καιρὸς ἐστὶν ἀποπλεῖν· σπεύδετε πρὸς τὴν ναῦν.”  
ταχέως ἔλυσαν τὰ πείσματα καὶ ἀπέπλευσαν.

οἱ δὲ Ἀθηναῖοι τὴν Ἀριάδνην ἔλιπον ἐν τῇ νήσῳ.  
ἡ Ἀριάδνη ἔδραμε καὶ ἔβλεψε πρὸς τὴν θάλατταν.  
“ὦ Θησεῦ, ποῦ εἶ; ἄρα με καταλείπεις; σῶζε με.  
μάλιστα φοβοῦμαι, καὶ λυποῦμαι.”

c. What was Ariadne doing, line 2? [2]  
d. To whom did Theseus speak, line 3? [1]  
e. What does he tell them, line 4? [4]  
f. What two things do they do, line 5? [2,2]

d. Give the first person singular, and second person plural, of the present tense  
of the verb καταλείπεις (line 8). [2]  
e. Give and translate a part of the verb "to be" from the first paragraph. [2]  
f. Give two different prepositions from the first paragraph, and state  
which case they govern. [4]  
g. Give an infinitive from the first paragraph and translate it. [2]
