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Requirements of the HKDSE Music Paper 1 Listening

Music Curriculum and Assessment Guide (Secondary 4 – 6)

- Listen to and study musical works from the following periods and genres: music in the Western classical tradition from the Baroque period to the 20th Century, Chinese instrumental music, Cantonese operatic music, and local and Western popular music.
- Use appropriate music terminology/notations to demonstrate the development of aural perception and knowledge about music elements, structures, expressive qualities and compositional devices.
- Describe and discuss music in relation to its historical and cultural contexts.





Requirements of the HKDSE Music Paper 1 Listening

- Music in the Western classical tradition:
 - e.g. opera, fugue, overture, concerto grosso, oratorio, cantata, suite, concerto, symphony, sonata, symphonic poem, art song, impressionism, neo-classicism and serialism.
- Chinese instrumental music:
 - e.g. *guqin* music, *pipa* music, *erhu* music, *dizi* music, *Jiangnan sizhu*, *Guangdong* music and Chinese orchestral music.





Requirements of the HKDSE Music Paper 1 Listening

Cantonese operatic music:

e.g. banghuang (qiziqingzhongban, shigonggunhua, fanxianshizijuzhongban, bazijuerhuangmanban), shuobai (bailan, shibai, koubai, kougu), manbannanyin (zhengxian, yifan) and xiaoqu.

 Local and Western popular music:
 e.g. Joseph Koo, Sam Hui, Elvis Presley and the Beatles.





Requirements of the HKDSE Music Paper 1 Listening

- Paper 1A Western Classical Music
- About 1 hour 15 minutes
- With 45 minutes break between 1A & 1B
- Paper 1B Chinese Instrumental Music,
 Cantonese Operatic Music, Local and Western
 Popular Music
- About 1 hour 15 minutes



Interpretation of the Marking Schemes

- The marking schemes should NOT be regarded as standardised model answers
- The marking schemes allow flexibility in marking
- Answers suggested in the marking schemes are NOT exhaustive
- Markers' discretion and professional judgement are necessary in marking the scripts



Scaled Mean Score (base 100) of Each Question


